 The Expeditions/Gardening Committee is a hybrid staff/parent/Board effort to promote

expeditionary learning through gardening programs.

At this stage, kindergarden students are going to be helped to prepare the ground for and install a single garden bed, in the Kinder instructional area. Kindergarten students will transplant seedlings they have grown indoors, to the outdoors and begin to garden there. Materials were delivered for this today, April 10th.

Another four garden beds will be installed by students through the Committee's efforts, for use with Karl Harris' gardening Club. Another three garden bed planters will be installed by students for use by the Expeditions Committee itself. Materials for this were delivered today, April 10th.

Troy Taylor, working with Dan and Green Guerrilla, is supporting all of these efforts.

A. IDOT and Entryway concerns

Dan Alexander spoke with Aaron Neal, City of Elgin Public Works Director who agreed to write on behalf of EMSA and the City of Elgin, to IDOT. Dan's request was to reduce speeds near EMSA, to install striping and signage with blinking lights similar to the situation by Coleman Elementary School.
