

#### **Products Due to OUSD**

#### Submission

- 1. Cover Letter with Arise Board Approval
- Renewal Petition with District Required Language
- 3. Performance Report
- 4. Financials
- 5. Redlined Petition
- 6. PPT for Public Hearing

#### Site Visit (two weeks before submission)

- 1. Two Day Visit includes:
  - a. Focus groups of students, staff, families, and board
  - b. Classroom Visits
  - c. Leader interviews
- 2. Documentation that needs to be submitted before visit
  - a. Staff and Student Handbook
  - b. Admission Policies
  - c. Building compliance
  - d. Survey results
  - e. PD Schedule
  - f. Bell Schedule

### **AB 1505 - A New Era in California Charter Renewal**

• AB1505 is a policy that went into effect July 1, 2020

- Substantially changed renewal process and criteria from API system to a 3-Track System. (Low, Medium, and High) based on two criteria:
  - 1) overall performance of all students on the state dashboard, and
  - 2a) overall performance compared to state averages, and
  - 2b) subgroup performance of students compared to state averages for those subgroups on the state dashboard.

#### **AB 1505 - A New Era in California Charter Renewal**

- Focus on CA School Dashboard
- Now includes College/Career Preparedness & ELL Progress
- Puts gap closing schools in the high tier (schoolwide & subgroups)
- New "second look" construct
  - Allows for alternative, robust measures of achievement and postsecondary success
- Fiscal, governance, and student admissions issues are allowable for non-renewal, but only if authorizer has provided notice and opportunity to correct the issue

### **Three Track Renewal Criteria**

State indicators: Academic Indicators (ELA, Math, EL, CCI), Suspension Rates, Chronic Absenteeism, Grad Rate

	High Track	Middle Track	Low Track
ALL Students	Schoolwide status must be blues/greens on all state indicators	Charter schools fall here if they do not fall in either the high or low track.	Schoolwide status must be orange/red on all state indicators
Closing Achievement Gap - Schoolwide & for Subgroups	Schoolwide status must be same or higher than state average status on academic indicators + underperforming subgroups must have a higher status than state average for that subgroup the academic indicators.	Is there evidence of increases in academic achievement?  Are there strong postsecondary outcomes as compared to similar peers? Authorizer are to consider the following in middle track renewals:

- CA Dashboard Indicators all state and local indicators for schoolwide and subgroups
- Greater weight on academic performance
- May deny only if it finds the charter failed to meet or make sufficient progress, that closure is in the best interest of the pupils
- Renewal term is 5 years
