  - Grades K-8: 75% of scholars exceed their MAP growth goal in math from Fall to Spring by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
  - Grades 3-8:75% of scholars exceed their MAP growth goal in ELA from Fall to Spring by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
    - Decide on Benchmarks for review against goals
