#### A. DIBELS - Literacy (K-3rd)

#### B. MAP Assessment

- Intervention supports needed for the following: 3rd grade (ELA), 4th grade (ELA), and 6th grade (ELA), & 8th Grade (ELA)
- Moved from 44th to 47th percentile in Math. Lots of growth from Winter to BOY. Above average.

- Intervention support needed for 5th, 6th, and 8th grades in the area of Math.
- Intervention support needed for 6th grade in the area of Science.

- Decreased 2% overall mastery and advanced.
- Science -16%
