Amazing and a huge success! We raised approximately \$64,000 total without corporate matches, \$76,500 with corporate matches. It can take 6-12 months to collect all of the corporate matches. Thank all of the teachers for all of their involvement.

The company does take a percentage of the money raised, but we aren't able to put on a program of this caliber ourselves. We haven't been able to raise this amount of money not using this style of company. The more money raised, the smaller the percentage that goes to the company. We will be working with the company to change some of the structure of the program to potentially reduce the individual goals. Fundraising is never completely equitable, but we are doing the best that we can. Please contact the PTO if you would like to help with this in the future.
