B. AoA Safe Haven Schools Resolution Vote Ron 15 Whittaker

State Superintendent of Public Instruction Tom Torlakson issued a letter Dec. 21 that encouraged schools throughout California to become "safe havens," which reflect the policies that sanctuary cities have adopted. The Academy of Alameda wants to make a public statement affirming support for all its students and their families - especially those who have recently been subjected to discriminatory actions.
