-Applications will be reviewed to verify all lottery preference: -Confirm available spots -Run mock lottery prior to catch and fix errors prior to real lottery

Communicate Lottery Results: Families Accept/Decline by March 23

Applications that have been chosen from the lottery will receive an offer. They will have until March 23 to accept or decline.

Waitlist placements will also be communicated at this time.

Follow Up Communications: Forms, Electives, Events And Waitlist Offers

- Communicate to newly accepted families about forms, electives, events, and other next steps
- -Continue to make waitlist offers as families decline


Complete registration and MS elective form by April 6, 2023

New ES enrollment targets increase enrollment in grades K, 1, 2, and 3 and lowers enrollment in grades 4 and 5. Increases overall enrollment to 312 compared to 302.

The number of returning students, plus the new offers is 155 students. However, we will continue to enroll 6th grade students due to foreseeable attrition.
