- \$30K of the \$60K contingency remains in FY17-18 driven by Professional Development cost overruns, high SPED program costs, lower than projected nutrition revenue and high nutrition expenses.
- The Finance Committee recommends that the Board approve a budget for the Foundation in August to track revenues and expenses related to expansion. A simple budget with the network level salaries will be presented at the next meeting. If the seats are granted a more detailed budget with facility and start-up costs will need to be reviewed and approved.
