B. FY21 Budget Update

Last Wednesday, Governor Baker filed a new \$45.5B FY21 budget. The proposed budget relies on a combination of federal relief money, tapping into the state's "rainy day" savings fund, and delaying planned increases to various state agency budgets. The Governor has asked the Legislature to approve a final FY21 budget by Thanksgiving, which means that another interim budget may be needed for the month of November. As proposed, the Governor's below are highlight to FY21 budget that pertain to Charter School Funding:

- Maintains current Ch. 70 funding levels for the rest of the fiscal year (level funding from FY20 + inflation for foundation rates) + CARES Act relief funds
- Delays implementation of the Student Opportunity Act (as predicted); and
- Maintains the charter facilities per pupil at \$938 per student
