

Previous Forecast vs. Current Forecast




TISA revenue drives \$13K increase to projected operating income

FY24 Financial Dashboard





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Lit Implementation Phase Learning Journey

Throughout the implementation phase of your learning journey Lit will work with the system's backbone literacy organization, a core group of leaders from the system that are responsible for the alignment and implementation of the research aligned reading ecosystem. This backbone organization should consist of the most senior level leader who has decision making rights over literacy programming and priority planning as well as network level leader(s) who are responsible for the implementation, monitoring, and coaching of others to implement all of the components of the reading ecosystem.

Staffing:

Lit will allocate the following staff:

- A Managing Partner to:
 - O Supervise the yearlong priority plan and ensure improvement cycles drive towards annual goals and priorities set in collaboration with the client
 - o Provide executive coaching to the decision-maker of the client's backbone organization
 - o Manage the partnership, act as the primary contact for the system and foster partnership health
- A Partner to:
 - Coach members of the client's backbone organization on critical leadership levers, such as:
 - Data strategy and analysis
 - System- and building-level observation and feedback
 - Priority planning and monitoring
 - Change management
 - Professional learning

Note: depending on the size of the engagement, Lit may need to add additional Partners to the partnership to ensure that all coaching, planning, and data cycles are completed as per our final agreement.

Implementation Engagement Details:

To support the growth and effectiveness of the reading ecosystem, our engagement features a continuous cycle of data analysis, action planning, observation, and coaching. This cycle will involve both virtual and in-person collaboration. Specifically, we will engage in up to four instructional coaching visits per year aligned with the natural data cycles of schools. Network-level leaders will have weekly touchpoints with Lit Partners between instructional coaching visits for ongoing coaching, data analysis, and action planning.

Instructional Coaching Visits

During each in-person session, the following objectives will guide our focus:

System and Building Level Leaders will:

- 1. Engage in monitoring and measuring their system's progress against their improvement cycle goals
- 2. Practice and receive feedback on crucial leadership levers such as
 - a. Data Analysis
 - b. Observation Feedback
 - c. Professional Development



d. Change Management

3. Engage in setting new goals for an upcoming improvement cycle

Lit School Support Staff will:

- Coach on critical leadership levers such as data analysis, observation and feedback, professional development, priority planning, and change management
- Provide real-time feedback on individual developmental goals and system goals aligned to the client's improvement cycle
- Support the client's backbone organization in measuring and monitoring progress and setting new goals for an upcoming improvement cycle

1-1 Leader Coaching

Between instructional coaching visits, the l-1 Leader Coaching aims to continuously enhance the reading ecosystem and develop system and network-level leaders' skills through a cyclical process of monitoring, coaching, practice, and planning.

Oversight Meetings

Oversight meetings involve collaborative problem-solving and feedback exchange to address partnership challenges as they arise.

CONSULTING AGREEMENT

THIS CONSULTING AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is dated this _____ day of

CLIENT

Memphis Merit Academy 4775 American Way, Memphis, TN 38118 (the "Client")

CONSULTANT

Envision Operations Cordova, TN 38016 (the "Consultant")

BACKGROUND

- A. The Client is of the opinion that the Consultant has the necessary qualifications, experience and abilities to provide consulting services to the Client.
- B. The Consultant is agreeable to providing such consulting services to the Client on the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the matters described above and of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, the Client and the Consultant (individually the "Party" and collectively the "Parties" to this Agreement) agree as follows:

SERVICES PROVIDED

- 1. The Client hereby agrees to engage the Consultant to provide the Client with the following consulting services (the "Services"):
 - 1. New Site Operations Planning:

We will streamlined planning for essential site operations, covering processes such as arrival and dismissal, nutrition services, facility maintenance schedules at the new site.

2. Project Management: Campus Relocation

We provide expert project management for campus relocation, ensuring a seamless and efficient transition. We will create key milestones, manage resources effectively, and mitigate risks using proven project management tools and techniques.

3. Operations Strategy Sessions with Executive Director: We address strategic areas

such as resource allocation, budget planning, and performance evaluation, fostering a shared vision for operational excellence.

- 4. Coaching and Onboarding: We provide personalized coaching and onboarding support for new and existing Operations leaders. Our coaching services encompass leadership development, team building, and change management, tailored to individual needs and goals..
- **2.** The Services will also include any other consulting tasks which the Parties may agree on. The Consultant hereby agrees to provide such Services to the Client.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

- **3.** The term of this Agreement (the "Term") will begin on February 20, 2024 and will remain in full force and effect until June 30, 2024, subject to earlier termination as provided in this Agreement. The Term may be extended with the written consent of the Parties.
- **4.** In the event that either Party wishes to terminate this Agreement prior to June 30, 2024, that Party will be required to provide 30 days' written notice to the other Party.

PERFORMANCE

5. The Parties agree to do everything necessary to ensure that the terms of this Agreement take effect.

CURRENCY

6. Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, all monetary amounts referred to in this Agreement are in USD (US Dollars).

COMPENSATION

- **7.** The Consultant will charge the Client for the Services at the rate of \$7,500.00 per month (the "Compensation").
- 8. The Client will be invoiced every two weeks.
- **9.** Invoices submitted by the Consultant to the Client are due within 30 days of receipt.

REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

- **10.** The Consultant will be reimbursed from time to time for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred by the Consultant in connection with providing the Services.
- **11.** All expenses must be pre-approved by the Client.

TRADE SECRETS

Consulting Agreement Page 3 of 6

12. Trade secrets (the "Trade Secrets") include but are not limited to any data or information, technique or process, tool or mechanism, formula or compound, pattern or test results relating to the business of the Client, which are secret and proprietary to the Client, and which give the business a competitive advantage where the release of that Trade Secret could be reasonably expected to cause harm to the Client.

13. The Consultant agrees that they will not disclose, divulge, reveal, report or use, for any purpose, any Trade Secrets which the Consultant has obtained, except as authorized by the Client or as required by law. The obligations of confidentiality will apply during the Term and will survive indefinitely upon termination of this Agreement.

OWNERSHIP OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- **14.** All intellectual property and related material (the "Intellectual Property") that is developed or produced under this Agreement, will be the property of the Consultant. The Client is granted a non-exclusive limited-use license of this Intellectual Property.
- **15.** Title, copyright, intellectual property rights and distribution rights of the Intellectual Property remain exclusively with the Consultant.

RETURN OF PROPERTY

16. Upon the expiration or termination of this Agreement, the Consultant will return to the Client any property, documentation, records, or confidential information which is the property of the Client.

CAPACITY/INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

17. In providing the Services under this Agreement it is expressly agreed that the Consultant is acting as an independent contractor and not as an employee. The Consultant and the Client acknowledge that this Agreement does not create a partnership or joint venture between them, and is exclusively a contract for service. The Client is not required to pay, or make any contributions to, any social security, local, state or federal tax, unemployment compensation, workers' compensation, insurance premium, profit-sharing, pension or any other employee benefit for the Consultant during the Term. The Consultant is responsible for paying, and complying with reporting requirements for, all local, state and federal taxes related to payments made to the Consultant under this Agreement.

RIGHT OF SUBSTITUTION

- **18.** Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the Consultant may, at the Consultant's absolute discretion, engage a third party sub-contractor to perform some or all of the obligations of the Consultant under this Agreement and the Client will not hire or engage any third parties to assist with the provision of the Services.
- **19.** In the event that the Consultant hires a sub-contractor:
 - the Consultant will pay the sub-contractor for its services and the Compensation will

remain payable by the Client to the Consultant.

 for the purposes of the indemnification clause of this Agreement, the sub-contractor is an agent of the Consultant.

AUTONOMY

20. Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the Consultant will have full control over working time, methods, and decision making in relation to provision of the Services in accordance with the Agreement. The Consultant will work autonomously and not at the direction of the Client. However, the Consultant will be responsive to the reasonable needs and concerns of the Client.

EQUIPMENT

21. Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the Consultant will provide at the Consultant's own expense, any and all equipment, software, materials and any other supplies necessary to deliver the Services in accordance with the Agreement.

NO EXCLUSIVITY

22. The Parties acknowledge that this Agreement is non-exclusive and that either Party will be free, during and after the Term, to engage or contract with third parties for the provision of services similar to the Services.

NOTICE

- **23.** All notices, requests, demands or other communications required or permitted by the terms of this Agreement will be given in writing and delivered to the Parties at the following addresses:
 - a. Memphis Merit Academy4775 American Way, Memphis, TN 38118
 - **b.** Envision Operations Cordova, TN 38016

or to such other address as either Party may from time to time notify the other, and will be deemed to be properly delivered (a) immediately upon being served personally, (b) two days after being deposited with the postal service if served by registered mail, or (c) the following day after being deposited with an overnight courier.

INDEMNIFICATION

This contract is entered into on July 22, 2024 between Memphis Merit Academy Charter School and The Learning Lounge K-12.

1. Term of Contract:

This Contract shall commence on July 22, 2024 and shall terminate on May 30, 2024, unless otherwise extended or terminated as per the terms herein.

- 2. Responsibilities of the Math Coach:
- a. **Weekly Math Coaching (Hybrid):** The Math Coach agrees to conduct weekly math coaching sessions, utilizing a hybrid model combining in-person and virtual instruction, focusing on Unit Internalization and Lesson Internalization Deliberate Practice.
- b. In-person Lesson Observations with Feedback: In-person lesson observations will occur bi-weekly, where the Math Coach will observe math lessons conducted by teachers at Memphis Merit Academy Charter School. The Math Coach will provide constructive feedback and recommendations for improvement based on the observations.
- c. **Quarterly Data Meetings**: The Math Coach shall participate in quarterly data meetings with Math teachers of Grades 2-6 to review student performance data, identify trends, and develop strategies for improvement.
- d. **Math Professional Development:** Upon return from each holiday break or based on the School's annual calendar for professional development, the Math Coach shall engage in Math Professional Development activities to enhance coaching methodologies and stay updated on best practices in math education.
- 3. School's Responsibilities:
- a. The School shall provide necessary resources, including access to student data, instructional materials, and facilities, to support the Math Coach in fulfilling their responsibilities.
- b. The School shall designate a liaison to facilitate communication and collaboration between the Math Coach and school staff.

4. Compensation:

- a. The Math Coach shall receive compensation of \$50,000 annually for the duration of this Contract.
- b. Payment shall be made on a monthly basis.
