#### CSO Report June 26, 2019

- I. State of School
  - a. Fourth graduation held June 8, 2019
    - i. Largest senior class to date.
    - ii. Student, faculty speakers elected by student body very successful.
    - iii. Musical performances by students.
    - iv. One student did not complete requirements by June 8 but will complete over the summer and should still complete within the time frame to be counted in the four-year graduation cohort (no dropouts this year). This would be a graduation rate of 100% based on seniors only. Our CGR is calculated based on students leaving school and returning; students transferring to an NC public high school are tracked but students who leave for out-of-state schools or private/home schools are not. We must demonstrate to DPI that they have left and not dropped out, and we cannot always do this. This may result in our CGR being lower. We can account for each student; our accounting may not always satisfy DPI.
  - b. AP Exams
    - i. 641 tests taken by RTHS students in 19 subject areas. 2 new subject areas were added this year (AP Physics C:Mechanics, Electromagnetism)
    - We have become a go-to alternate test site for students attending other schools in our area. 7 students from other schools took AP Chinese Language, and The College Board asked us to test two other students from other schools. This is more work for us with no benefit and we are watching this carefully.
- II. Administrative plans for summer
  - a. Develop clear schedule for faculty in advance of the beginning of the year
  - b. Update faculty handbook with new HR information and employee expectation information
  - c. Transition to ParentSquare communications platform
  - d. Develop professional development plans, schedule, and themes
  - e. Improve new employee onboarding and increase support for new faculty
  - f. Complete HR program updates as recommended from the audit.
