CSO Report October 21, 2020

I. State of School

- a. Membership
 - i. Month 2 ADM 588, current enrollment 584. Budget target was 574.
 - ii. I do not anticipate any substantial change in enrollment.

b. Funding status

- Finance committee will report this in detail. Anticipated revenue cut does not appear to be happening, so we are faced with a very different, very positive, budget situation.
- ii. I will work to revise budgeting to accommodate the new funding levels. I would appreciate the board's support in giving me some latitude to use this wisely. I will report on changes.

c. Open status

- i. Remain in remote until Jan. 1, then reconsider (see action item)
- ii. Currently developing hybrid open plan so that it is ready to go when we decide the date. We still have to wait for the Governor to allow Plan B (hybrid open) for high schools.
- iii. Status is based on DHHS data and other outside advice (ABC Science Collaborative, eg.), parent and teacher surveys.

II. Outreach

- a. I was invited to be a panelist at a town hall meeting facilitated by <u>Family Voices</u> on October 14. The topic was racism in schools, and I was invited because of the black history playlist I created two years ago for students.
- b. Jeff Guilford, Jessi Stokes, and I have been attending an online conference with <u>EdElements</u> called The New School Rules, based on improving leadership and changing the format of collaboration in school structure.

III. Charter Renewal

- a. Process started with a letter signed by Gary requesting that our charter be renewed. That was submitted to OCS.
- b. Submitted a letter explaining all instances of non-compliance we have been notified of since we opened. It is not a long list and most of the items are insubstantial.
- c. We are now writing a self-reflection statement with some goals pulled from our strategic planning session. I will include board goals from the retreat as well.
- d. A future step will require meetings with board members. I will let you know when that happens. Any meetings will likely be virtual.



To Whom it May Concern:

After consultation with the school's Administrative Team and considering the results of parent, student, and faculty surveys, as well as disease conditions in North Carolina and the relatively few weeks of available instructional time remaining, I have decided to recommend to the RTHS Board of Directors that Research Triangle High School remain closed under Plan C and continue to operate fully remotely until Jan. 1. 2021.

The school's leadership will continue to evaluate conditions and make further recommendations on opening as Jan. 1 approaches.

The school will have a reopening plan in place prior to January 1, 2021, regardless of any later decision on actually opening Jan. 1.

I request that the RTHS Board of Directors approve this request.
