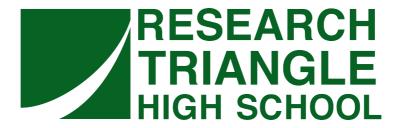

CSO Report Feb. 17, 2021

I. State of School

a. Lottery progress

- i. 522 applicants as of 2/17. Exactly on par with previous years.
- ii. Lottery closes 2/28, with draw on 3/12.
- iii. Draw pools TBD

b. COVID incident

- i. 2 men's basketball players tested positive. One attended PSAT testing before knowing he was positive. Student passed DHHS screening.
- ii. All students and staff who were in contact with the student were contacted. No one appears to have been infected from contact. Students and faculty in testing were masked and observing 6' distancing.
- iii. Men's basketball suspended for two weeks for quarantine.
- iv. Durham public health was contacted from the outset and worked with the students to do contact tracing.
- v. PSAT was required by College Board to be held on site.
- vi. 2 more on-site required tests in February and March, involving approximately 350 students (pre-ACT and ACT).

c. Reopen plans

- i. None of the plans before the legislature addresses RTHS' concerns about educational quality loss due to hybrid learning.
- ii. Despite lower relative quality of remote instruction compared to ideal face to face instruction, RTHS' efforts are not comparable to the broader state of traditional public high school remote efforts.
- iii. We will follow the law should it apply to charter schools, and are revisiting our opening plans should we need to deploy them.

d. Physical plant efforts

- i. Still waiting on HVAC work to start. Contract was signed in January.
- ii. Landscaping plan/walkthrough shared with staff. Positive reception.
- iii. Awaiting proposals for interior work (furniture, walls, floors). We have met with the vendors and the planning has started. We hope to have offers soon so that we can update budget needs.

e. Staff

- i. Visa transfer process for teacher has taken far longer than expected and we are giving up on placing her this year. Two teachers have been teaching at 140% load expecting a short tenure but will remain and finish the year to avoid separation problems with students. [personal note: I am burned on future visa support prospects]
- ii. Personnel issue to discuss in executive session.
- iii. We are advertising to hire an additional math teacher.
- iv. We are deploying a long-term sub in English to work with literacy supports now that the principal teacher has returned from leave.

II. CSO-centered

- a. I have reviewed the results of the CSO eval survey and will be addressing the concerns brought by faculty in their comments (and thanking them for their input otherwise)
- b. I have discussed with faculty a strategic plan for moving RTHS towards a mastery-based curriculum built on the Summit system but directly addressing state requirements.
 - i. This will take several years.
 - ii. This will require changing how RTHS interfaces with colleges, as it will affect how credits are represented
 - iii. It has the potential to allow the school to increase enrollment, better serving its mission statement.
 - iv. This was positively received by the faculty. I have not yet presented it to the academic excellence committee because I missed our last meeting. I will do so for their advice and wisdom in shaping the idea.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN RESEARCH TRIANGLE HIGH SCHOOL AND DISCOVERY CHARTER SCHOOL

I. INTRODUCTION

In 2016, the North Carolina General Assembly passed House Bill 242 modifying certain provisions in the charter school law to allow a charter school to give enrollment priority to students enrolled in another charter school that does not offer the next grade level. Accordingly, North Carolina General Statute Section 115C-218.45(f)(6) now provides:

The charter school may give enrollment priority to any of the following: ...

(6) A student who was enrolled in another charter school in the State in the previous school year that does not offer the student's next grade level and both of the charter schools have an enrollment articulation agreement to accept students or are governed by the same board of directors.

This Articulation Agreement between the signatory schools, Research Triangle High School ("RTHS") and Discovery Charter School ("DCS"), is intended to utilize this provision in this charter law to allow RTHS to give enrollment priority to students at DCS as set forth herein. This Articulation Agreement sets forth the eligibility requirements for DCS students to receive priority lottery position at RTHS. It also sets forth the process RTHS and DCS will utilize under this Articulation Agreement.

II. PURPOSE/INTENT

Discovery Charter School is a 6-8 public charter school and does not offer high school. DCS is a STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, mathematics) focused charter school with a diverse student population comprised of majority minority students many of whom are from disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds. The mission of DCS is to prepare students to be self-motivated, lifelong, independent and collaborative learners through a challenging STEAM-focused curriculum in an innovative and supportive environment. DCS endeavors to provide its students with a variety of choices for high school in accordance with each student's interests and academic strengths.

RTHS is a high school offering grades 9-12. The mission of Research Triangle High School is to increase access to globally competitive Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) education for students and teachers across North Carolina, by incubating, proving and scaling innovative models of teaching and learning. As part if its mission, RTHS is committed to increasing access to STEM education for minority and socio-economically disadvantaged students.

The Articulation Agreement between the signatory schools, RTHS and DCS, is intended to further the mission of each school and provide an opportunity for DCS students who wish to continue their education at a public charter school as contemplated by North Carolina General Statute 115C-218.45(f)(6).

III. ELIGIBLITY

To be eligible to receive priority enrollment at RTHS, a DCS student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be enrolled in DCS as an 8th grader at the time the student submits a lottery application.
- 2. Academically prepared to be able to complete Algebra I by the end of 9th grade.

IV. PROCESS

If a DCS student meets the eligibility requirements set forth in this Articulation Agreement, that student will be given priority enrollment at RTHS for the academic year for which the student is applying pursuant to RTHS's priority enrollment policies, which are attached hereto as Appendix A. However, nothing in this Articulation Agreement guarantees that an DCS student will be offered admission to RTHS. Representatives at each signatory school will meet either in person or via telephone to discuss any student interested in the priority enrollment set forth under this Articulation Agreement as necessary.

V. BOARD APPROVAL/TERMINATION

In accordance with North Carolina law, this Articulation Agreement must be voted on and adopted by each signatory school's Board of Director's as set forth in their bylaws. Once adopted, the signatory schools will sign this Articulation Agreement. Each signatory school reserves the right to terminate this Articulation Agreement at any time by providing written notice to the other school.

APPENDIX A

RTHS current Board Admissions/Lottery Policies, with 2.e. to be approved at January 2021 BOD meeting

- 1. Lottery
- a. If it is discovered after the student's name has been drawn in the lottery that information was withheld from the school during the application process, and this information would have made the student ineligible for admission to RTHS, the school may rescind the offer of admission and remove the student from the school's enrollment.
- b. In keeping with the school's mission of increasing access to globally competitive STEM education, as stated in the charter application, 40% of the incoming ninth grade class is reserved for students entering Math 1.
- 2. Lottery Preferences (all refer to G.S. 115C-238.29F(g)(5a)): Preferences will be given to students meeting the following conditions, according to RTHS Board policy and NC General Statute:
- a. Siblings of currently enrolled students who were admitted to the charter school in a previous year. For the purposes of this subsection, the term "siblings" includes any of the following who reside in the same household: half siblings, stepsiblings, and children residing in a family foster home.
- b. Siblings of students who have completed the highest grade level offered by that school and who were enrolled in at least four grade levels offered by the charter school or, if less than four grades are offered, in the maximum number of grades offered by the charter school.
- c. Limited to no more than fifteen percent (15%) of the school's total enrollment, unless granted a waiver by the State Board of Education, the following:
- i. Children of the school's full-time employees. In the event that an employee is hired after the lottery for that year has been drawn, the student may still be enrolled. Children of employees may be eligible for enrollment if they are rising eleventh or rising twelfth graders.
 - ii. Children of the charter school's Board of Directors.
- d. A student who was enrolled in the charter school within the two previous school years but left the school (i) to participate in an academic study abroad program or a competitive admission residential program or (ii) because of the vocational opportunities of the student's parent.
- e. RTHS will allow students who attend Global Scholars Academy, Maureen Joy Charter School, Healthy Start Academy, or Discovery Charter School to be granted enrollment priority under NC G.S. 115C-218.45(f)(b).
- f. RTHS will grant admissions preference for children of all employees. In the event that an employee is hired after the lottery for that year has been drawn, the student may still be enrolled. Children of employees may be eligible for enrollment if they are rising eleventh or rising twelfth graders.

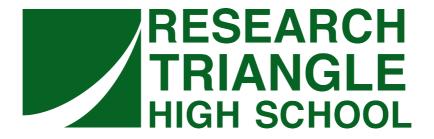

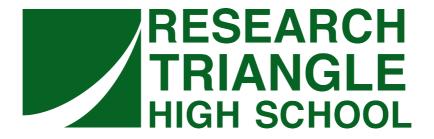

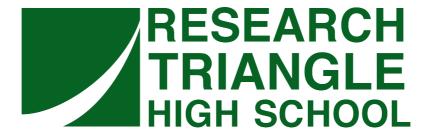
