

Pledge Agreement

This pledge agreement is entered into on the 8th day of August 2023, between Reach Cyber School ("Reach") and the Da Vinci Discovery Center of Science Technology, ("Da Vinci"). Reach desire/s to make a gift commitment to Da Vinci in the amount of \$25,000, (Twenty-Five thousand dollars), as described more fully below, in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Commitment. Da Vinci desires to accept the gift subject to such terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

In consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

- 1. Reach agrees to pay this \$25,000 pledge to be invoiced on September 1, 2023.
- 2. \$20,000 of this gift is to support the unrestricted operations of the Da Vinci Science Center outlined below. The remaining \$5,000 is to support Da Vinci's WISE Forum on November 14, 2023.
- 3. In recognition of the charter school's generosity, Da Vinci will provide the following sponsorship benefits through June 30, 2024:
 - 100 free admissions for Reach families.
 - A 15% discount on memberships for Reach families. 0
 - One facility rental to accommodate a back-to-school celebration including complimentary admission for Reach families and the use of a classroom in our current building during normal operating hours. Date and time to be coordinated with the Science Center. Any decorations or catering would be at Reach's expense.
 - Six individual classroom rentals in our current building during the agreement period for a total of 9 days for the calendar year of 2023 and Winter of 2024 (Jan & Feb).
 - Recognition as the sponsor of the schools out camp program and summer camp program during 0 the agreement period.
 - 10 Summer camp registrations for Reach students. 0
 - A 10% discount for additional Reach students to attend camps. 0
 - WISE Forum Sponsorship of \$5,000 to introduce female high school and college students to strong 0 role models who have pursued STEM leadership opportunities in different industries and to inspire those students to expand their career aspirations. This networking event includes dinner and is followed by a public discussion featuring a panel of distinguished female leaders in STEM from across the nation.
- Da Vinci is recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization. Donors are responsible for seeking the advice of their tax advisor to determine whether their charitable contributions are tax-deductible.
- 5. The terms and conditions of this Commitment may not be orally amended, modified, or altered, but may be amended, modified, or altered only in writing signed by the Donor(s) and Da Vinci.
