



What is one way we can do to make you feel safer at school?


- More security presence (e.g., police officers or staff patrols).

- More frequent safety drills or awareness programs.


Learning Environment

I feel challenged and motivated to do my best in school by my teachers and peers. 350 responses




If you were in charge, what changes would you make to improve the school's learning environment?

- Enhanced classroom resources and infrastructure.


Student Advocacy

The teachers, counselors and principals encourage me to take an active role in my education (advocate, ask help when I need it, try new ideas and classes) ³⁵⁰ responses




What is one way we can better ensure your voice can be heard and feel safer asking for support?

- Increase visibility and accessibility of counselors or support staff.


Student Experiences




What programs and experiences should we add to the school year?

- Plan additional field trips and outdoor experiences.


Teacher Support

I believe that most, if not all of my teachers care about my success and personal well-being. 350 responses




Most, if not all of my teachers this year are approachable and make themselves available when I need help.




I feel as though I am valued and treated with respect at this school. 350 responses

The school creates a learning environment and sense of community where students from all backgrounds feel included. 350 responses




What is one area of our school that our talk (School Written Rules or The Seaside Way) does not match our actions?


- Ensure consistent enforcement of school rules.


The school and teachers keeps me informed about important updates and events (week of, newsletters, teacher messages, classroom boards) ³⁵⁰ responses

Daily communication from my teachers is clear and effective. 350 responses




What is one way we can improve the school's or teachers' overall communication?

- Implement systems to track and respond to student concerns.


Student Wellness and Mental Health

I feel comfortable seeking help from an adult on campus if I am struggling emotionally or mentally. ³⁵⁰ responses




What is one idea you have to improve the well-being of our students?

- Add designated break periods during the school day.


Future Readiness

The school academic and extracurricular programs helps me prepare for my future (high school, college, career, or other goals).



I have opportunities in school to learn life skills that will help me after graduation. 350 responses




What additional "Future Readiness" programs and experiences need improvement or should we consider adding?


- Offer career-focused programs like coding or financial literacy.


Every day that I am at school I feel like I belong in this school community. 350 responses




I have positive relationships with most of my classmates and peers. 350 responses

I am comfortable asking my peers for assistance with a problem or to explain how to complete the assignment? 350 responses




What do we need to do better in this area?

- Continue fostering a positive and inclusive school culture.


Homework

The daily homework assigned supports independent learning and reinforces the skills taught in class.



Most of the time my homework is graded and I receive feedback on my efforts. 350 responses




How many hours per day/night on average do you spend doing homework? ³⁵⁰ responses
