## E-Rate - Category 2 Funding Overview

- Background
  - E-Rate: A federal program providing discounts of 20% to 90% to help schools and libraries afford high-speed internet and telecommunications.
  - Category 2: A specific funding slice dedicated to internal connections, covering the hardware and services needed to distribute Wi-Fi throughout a building (like routers, switches, and cabling).
- Funding Cycle
  - 5 years
  - FY2026-27 to FY2031-32
- CNCA
  - 85% discount
  - ~\$500,000

## Cisneros Full Network Refresh Project

- Project background:
  - A complete replacement of network hardware at Cisneros campus
- Impact:
  - Cisneros' network infrastructure is outdated and unable to support our new and safer internet policies
  - A revamp allows Cisneros to be able to close a security gap in the network that is resolved by replacing the hardware
- Fiscal impact:
  - Upon approval from USAC (FCC designed organization that manages E-Rate program), 85% of the project is funded and 15% is paid by CNCA
