Net Income / (Loss)

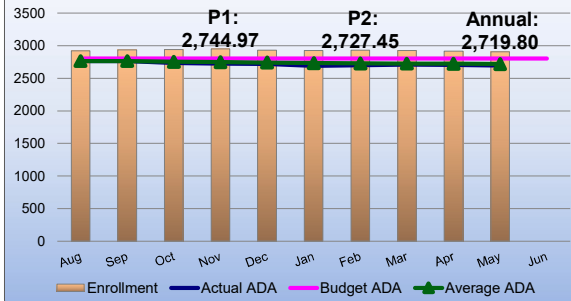

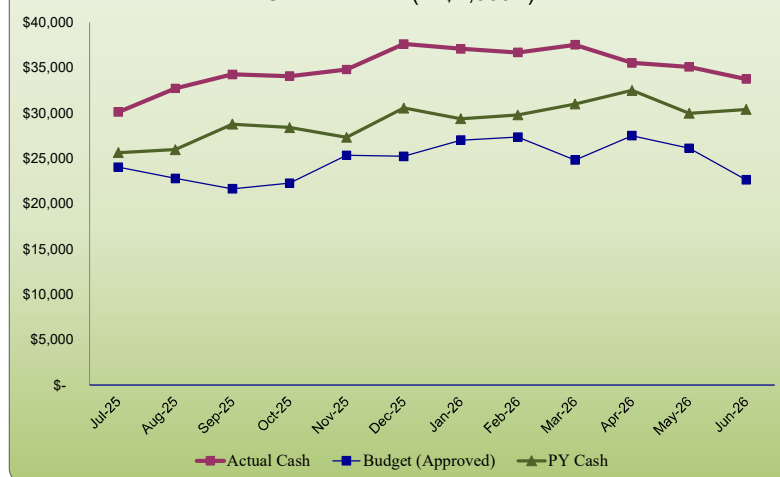

Camino Nuevo Charter Academy - Consolidated Financial Analysis June 2026

Net Income

Camino Nuevo Charter Academy - Consolidated achieved a net income of \$662K in FY25-26 compared to \$483K in the board approved budget. Reasons for this positive \$179K variance are explained below in the Income Statement section of this analysis.

Balance Sheet

As of June 30, 2026, the school's unrestricted cash balance was \$17.09M, which represents a 27% reserve. In addition to this, CNCA has \$16.7M of restricted cash. This includes \$4.9M of Employee Retention Credit (ERC) funds.

As of June 30, 2026, the Accounts Receivable balance was \$6.77M, up from \$1.73M in the previous month, due to the recording of FY25-26 funds earned but not yet received.

As of June 30, 2026, the Accounts Payable balance, including payroll liabilities, totaled \$3.80M, compared to \$4.10M in the prior month.

As of June 30, 2026, CNCA had a debt balance of \$8.60M. This debt is related to Prop 55/Kayne Siart construction loan.

Income Statement

Revenue

Total revenue for FY25-26 is \$66.26M, which is \$972K or 1.4% under budgeted revenue of \$67.23M.

All Other Federal Revenue (8299) \$176K decrease based on final allocations of 21st Century afterschool grant.

Expanded Learning Opportunity Program (8595) \$1.1M decrease in Expanded Learning Opportunity Program funds due to sites spending less than budgeted on field trips, consultants and supplies. In addition to this, there were some funds released to be spent in future years.

Prop 28 Arts & Music (8596) \$475K increase based on increased spending toward this fund. All schools added arts and music related expenses to maximize their FY23-24 award that expired June 2026.

State Revenue - Other (8599) \$1,283K decrease is primarily due to Learning Recovery and Literacy Coach funds that are now to be spent in future years.

Interest & Dividend Income (8660) \$972K increase in interest revenue upon the receipt of LACOE's fourth quarter adjustments from prior year as well as the first three quarters of the current year. In addition, this includes estimated funds to be received for the fourth quarter.

Contributions & Events (8695) \$105K increase due to funds raised by sites.

SELPA Grants (8698) \$126K increase based on special education assistance grants awarded to each charter.

Expenses

Total expenses for FY25-26 are \$65.60M, which is \$1.15M or 1.7% under budgeted expenditures of \$66.75M.

Teachers' Salaries - Substitute (1170) \$317K over budget, which includes an additional resident sub teacher at the Cisneros site. This position was added to combat the increased costs of third-party substitute companies.

Instructional Aide & Other Salaries (2111) \$267K under budget due to vacant positions, including Behavior Interventionist positions that are covered by third-party providers (**5842**).

Classified Teacher Salaries (2131) \$134K under budget partly due to less usage of afterschool intervention staff at Burlington and one Castellanos intervention position being changed to a certificated role under Teacher's hourly account (**1120**).

Student Materials (4311) \$224K over budget due to additional supply purchases being made with one-time funds.

Non Capitalized Equipment (4411) \$480K over largely due to Dalzell Lance purchasing instruments with their Prop 28 Arts and Music in School funds, Burlington purchasing furniture for their middle school and other sites purchasing additional technology with one-time funds.

Utilities (5511) \$133K under budget across the network based on all final billing.

Other Facility Rentals (5619) \$359K under budget due to FY24-25 property tax reimbursements received.

Vendor Repairs (5631) \$277K under budget based on final billings and reduced costs across the network.

Field Trips & Pupil Transportation (5812) \$187K under budget largely due to budgeted ELOP trips that were not done.

Contracted Substitute Teachers (5841) \$369K over budget because of teacher vacancies and absenteeism.

Special Education Services (5842) \$77K over budget. This increase is large due to substitute expenses related to SpED staff and offset on cost savings on SpED services being rendered to students.

All Other Consultants & Services (5859) \$475K over budget partially due to classified staff support being obtained from consultants to cover vacancies or staff being absent. In addition, this includes Avance Resident payments being made to partner schools. The Avance payments are offset by increased grant funds (**8692**).

Budgeted P2 ADA is 2,803.98 based on enrollment of 2,991 and a 93.7% attendance rate.

P2 ADA is 2,727.09 based on enrollment of 2,927 and a 93.0% attendance rate.

Actual ADA through Month 10 is 2,719.80 with ending enrollment of 2,907 and a 92.9% attendance rate.

In Month 10, ADA was 2,697.04 with a 92.7% attendance rate.
