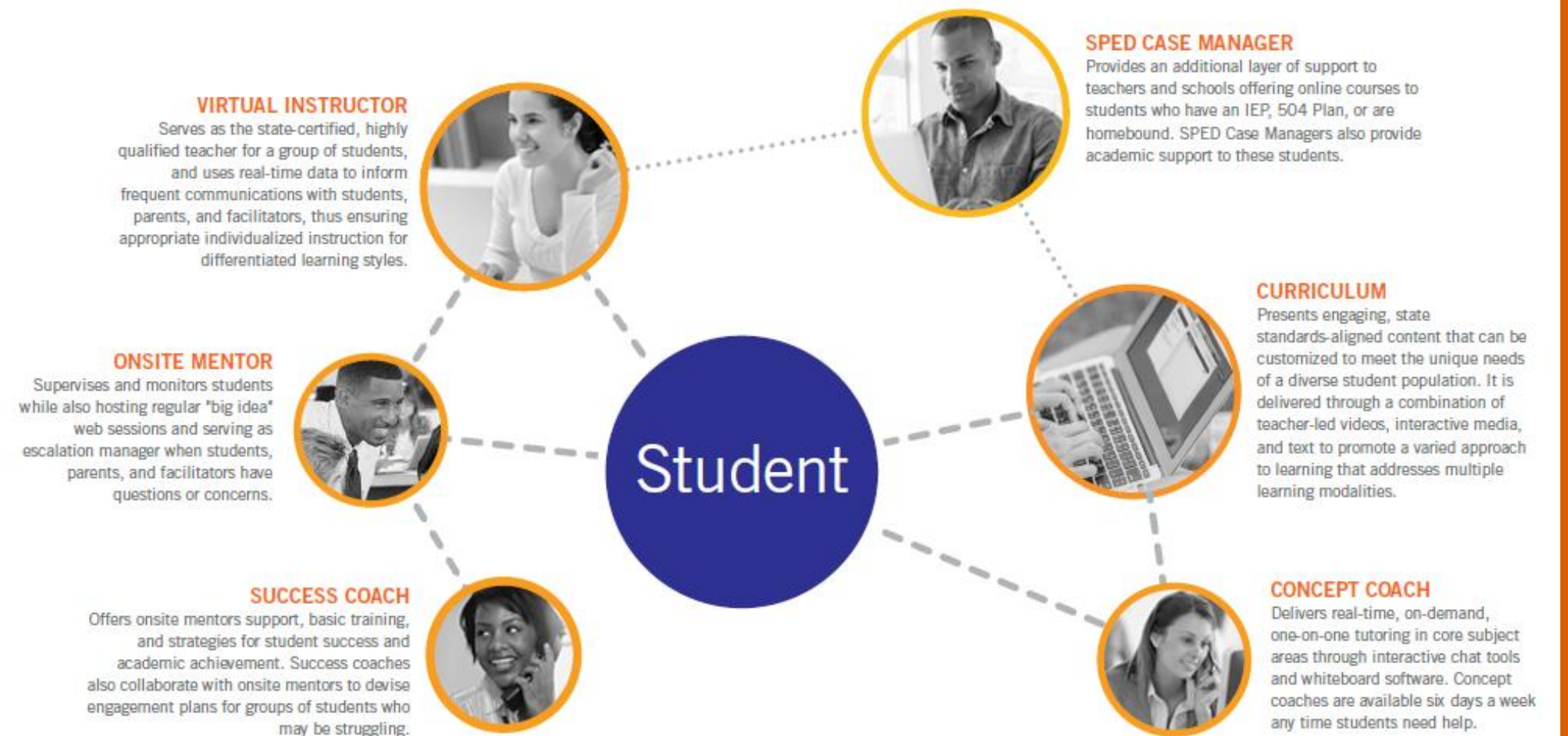

Long-Term External Independent Study with Edgenuity

Edgenuity Instructional Services

Multiple layers of support for effective online learning

With Edgenuity Instructional Services, students can take online courses from home, in a school computer lab, or as part of a full-time virtual program. No matter how they're learning, students have access to a support system that motivates, communicates with, and guides them.



Why Did We Pick Edgenuity?:

- We researched 4 vendors, including Edgenuity
- Most vendors required that we unenroll our students from Camino and enroll them in an online school
- Edgenuity was one of the few that allowed students to keep a guaranteed spot at CNCA
- We have a history of successful partnership with Edgenuity at the high school level for course enhancement (e.g., kids taking French after we stopped offering French) and credit recovery
- They offer personalized, standards-based learning, which means our students can work at a pace that meets their needs (i.e., slower or faster depending on incoming skill level)
- Edgenuity's company size gives us confidence that they come with the infrastructure needed to navigate the complexities of AB130 (independent study legislation), our changing needs due to the volatility of the pandemic, and our customer service needs (e.g., technology, student progress tracking, family support, CNCA-staff support, etc.).

Program requirements:

SYNCHRONOUS INSTRUCTION - Can be classroom, small group or one on one.
(no time constraints provided)

- Documented synchronous instruction required -
 - DAILY for TK – 3,
 - WEEKLY for 4-8 with daily live interactions (required)
 - WEEKLY for HS.

LIVE INTERACTIONS – in person or online (no time constraints provided)

- Purpose: maintain connectedness to the LEA.
 - Documented wellness checks, progress checks
 - Classified or Certificated Staff

No more than 20% of our students can participate without triggering a material revision.

Special Education Program requirements:

Compliance within IS - LEA are required to complete an annual IEP to document change (IS) in educational setting in FAPE 2 Additional Notes within 30 days of enrollment.

Service Provisions and Tracking- LEA will continue to provide all IEP identified services in the annual iep that documents Independent Study (exceptions include students with Moderate to Severe disabilities). Site will continue to monitor all services for SWDs to ensure service delivery and IEP timelines are still met.

Instructional Support LEAs are required to review assignments for SWDs on IS to ensure that Edgenuity is appropriately providing the required designated supports and accommodations.

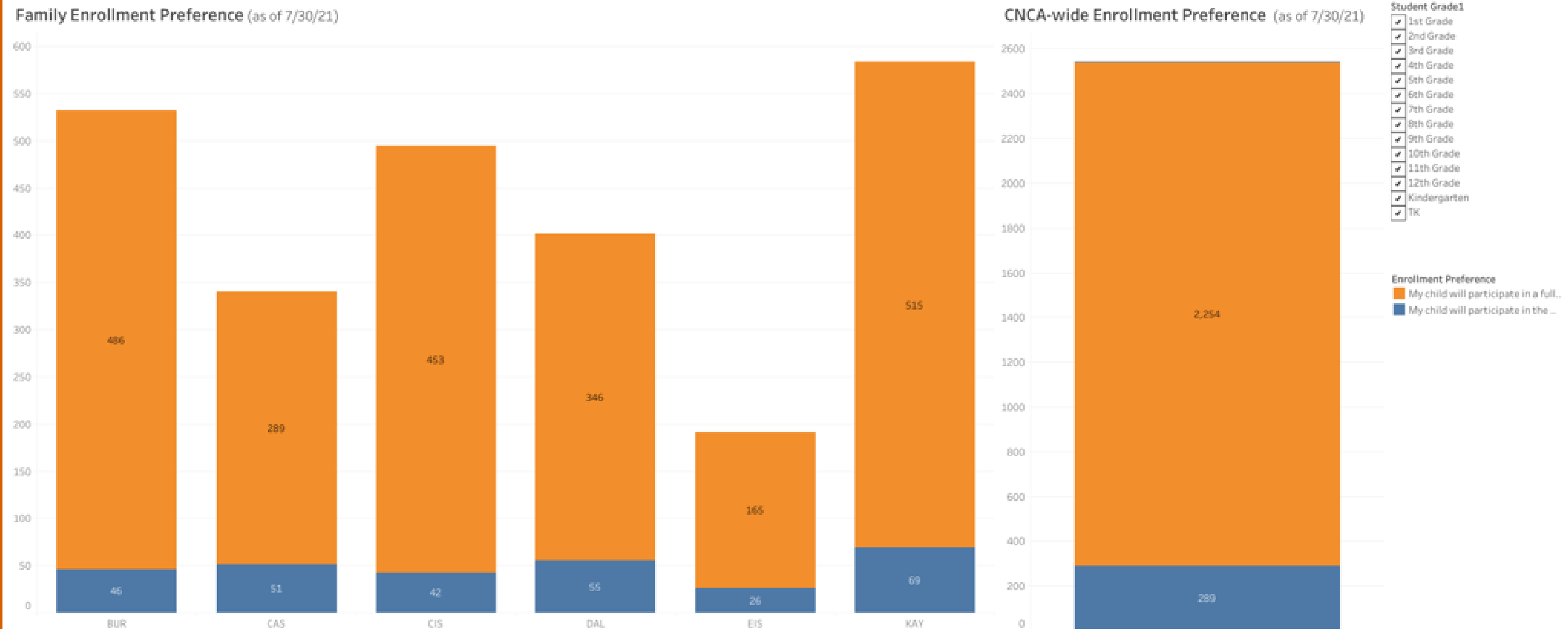
Staffing & Coordination Sr. Director of Special Education has requested two (2) RSP Case Managers to facilitate the coordination of IEPs and case management of SWDs on IS with a focus on Section K accommodations and ELPAC and SBAC testing.

Parent Messaging Regarding Long Term External IS:

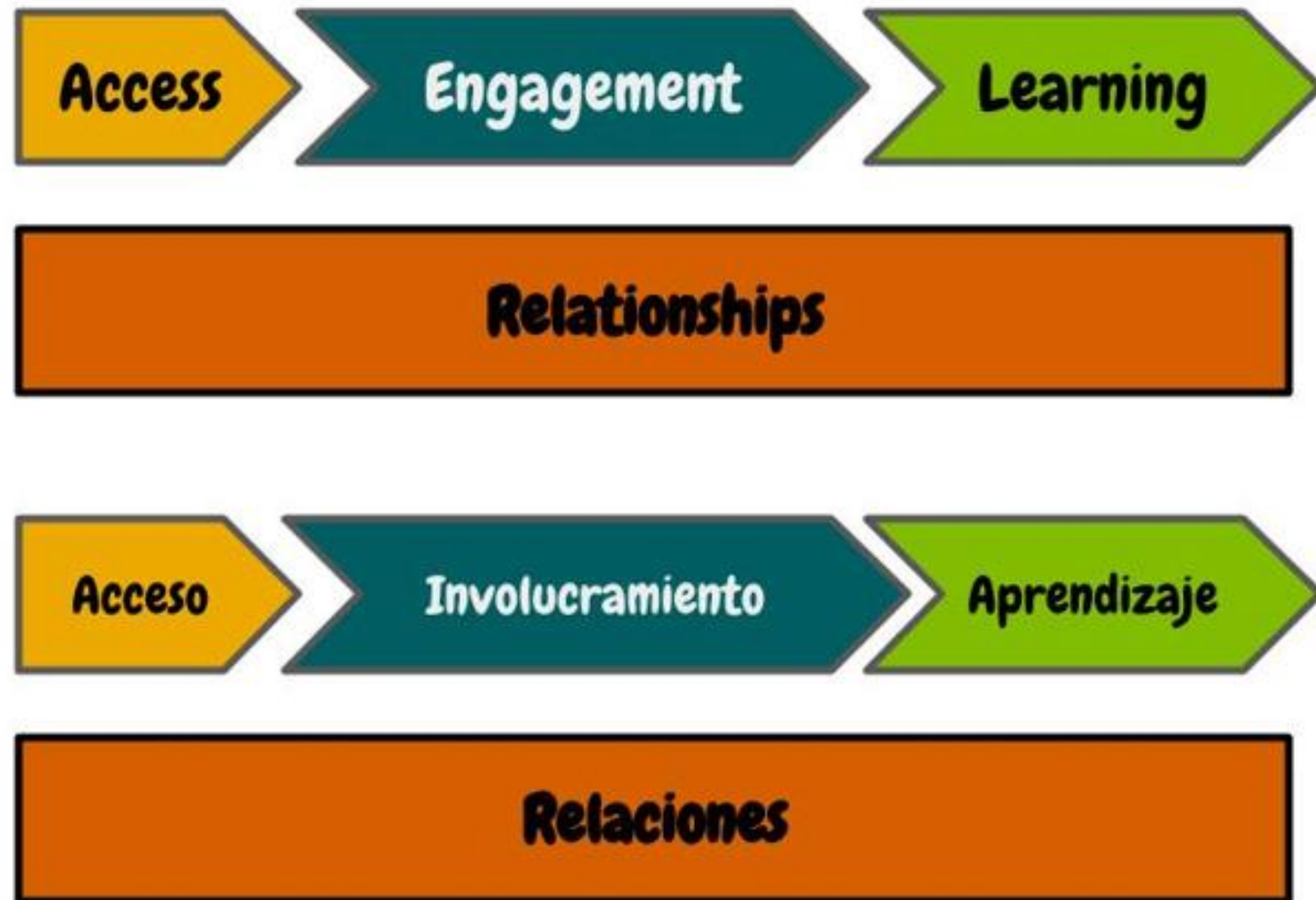
BIG IDEA: Because we know that high quality in-person instruction is the best for supporting students, we highly encourage families to return to CNCA in-person for all grade levels especially TK-3.

- This will not be the same as the Distance Learning program that students/families experienced last year (outlined the differences).
- Edgenuity uses their own platforms and their own teachers. The academic program will be different than CNCA.
- While CNCA will perform wellness and progress checks, families will need to communicate with Edgenuity if they have questions/concerns with the academic program/teacher (CNCA can direct them to the process).
- All instruction will be conducted in English. They do not have a bilingual model.
- All students from all schools across the state will be grouped together. This is not CNCA specific.
- Parents/Adult will need to commit to supporting their child's Independent Study program. They are an integral part of their child's success with Edgenuity.
- While we do have this offering for all students, we are most concerned that this may be very challenging for TK-3 students due to the need for digital literacy.

Short Term IS (Whole Class) with Camino Nuevo:

Given the rise of COVID cases, we are anticipating closures for quarantine of **10 calendar days** at any point throughout the year.

- In these cases if able, CNCA teachers will provide synchronous instructional time as well as asynchronous assignments.
- CNCA Staff will also conduct the live interactions requirement.
- Students will use Google classroom as well as our online platforms.

Short Term IS (Small Group) with Camino Nuevo:

Given the rise of COVID cases, we are anticipating closures for quarantine of **10 calendar days** at any point throughout the year.

- Packets or google classroom
- Access to CNCA online learning platforms (e.g., iReady & Rosetta Stone, as applicable)
- One wellness check from a CNCA employee
- One opportunity to attend office hours for instructional support

IS Policy Revisions

Independent Study Policy REVISIONS

- Required Parent Educator Conference for all families requesting IS - Edgenuity & CNCA must be present.
- Missed Assignments and trigger for evaluation
 - Satisfactory progress monitored or a Re-engagement plan is implemented
- Submission of assignments (procedure)
- Maximum length of assignment (time allotments)
- Methods of study and methods of evaluation
- All supports provided to students on IS – ELL, SpED, GATE, etc.
- Resources – connectivity and devices confirmed or provided by the school
- Course credit requirements
- Transition Plan (return to classroom based program within 5 days of written request)
- Parent engagement required
