#### A. BCCSG Principal's report and school update

## K. Ford presented:

- Current Enrollment 4 pupils under budgeted number
- Re-registration Number of re-registrations lower than desired.
  - Families are being reminded that re-registration is required to reserve a spot for the 2019-2020 school year.
- Staffing one new AIS teacher started recently.
- Interim Assessment #2 results
  - Largest take-away: One area in which the scholars need to improve is understanding and solving word problems. She plans to develop a schoolwide strategy to address this area.
- Proposed Staffing Model for 2019-2020.
  - This will be discussed in more detail at the next Academic Committee meeting and as part of the 2019-2020 budget creation process.
- Upcoming:
  - Work with the Albany Charter School Network to develop in school Math assessments
  - K. Ford and a few teachers will visit a school using Cognitive Guided Math Instruction to learn more about this approach.
