By June 2028, the percentage of all OPA students, including students in the Students With Disabilities (SWD), Economically Disadvantaged (EDA), and Hispanic (HI7) subgroups, meeting math proficiency will increase by **18%** as measured by USBE Summative Assessments.

- 5% increase in FY26 **We had 2% increase 16% to 18%**
- **9%** increase in FY27
- 7% increase in FY28

The MGP for all OPA students, including students in the SWD, EDA, and HI7 subgroups, in math will increase from **44** (57.0 Junior High) (30.5 Elementary) in 2024 to no less than **66** in 2028 as measured by USBE Summative Assessments.

ELA Goals

By June 2028, the percentage of all OPA students, including students in the Students With Disabilities (SWD), Economically Disadvantaged (EDA), and Hispanic (HI7) subgroups, meeting ELA proficiency will increase by **18%** as measured by USBE Summative Assessments.

- 6% increase in FY26 **We maintained - 0% increase; 19% to 19%**
- **13%** increase in FY27
- 5% increase in FY28

The MGP for all OPA students, including students in the SWD, EDA, and HI7 subgroups, in ELA will increase from **47** (51.5 Junior High) (41.0 Elementary) in 2024 to no less than **66** in 2028 as measured by USBE Summative Assessments.
