This Independent Contractor Services Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into effective January 23, 2023 by and between the Excel Academy Charter School ("School") and Adam Stein ("Contractor").

- 1. Contractor Services. The contractor agrees to provide temporary assistance, support, and guidance, in a professional advisory capacity, to the Chief Executive Officer operations. The parties anticipate that Contractor will provide these services approximately
- Contractor Qualifications. Contractor represents that it has in effect all licenses, 2. permissions, and has otherwise all legal qualifications to perform the Agreement.

Term. The Agreement shall begin on _____, and terminate on _____2023. The total amount payable will not exceed \$6,000. There shall be no extension of the Agreement without express written consent of all parties.

- Payment. School agrees to pay Contractor at the rate of \$150 per hour. Checks 4. will be made payable to Adam Stein. Payments shall be limited to amount written in this paragraph. School agrees to pay Contractor within thirty (30) days of receipt of a detailed invoice.
- 5. Incidental Expense. Contractor shall be responsible for all expenses associated with the Agreement, including lodging, meals, travel, supplies, and other incidental expenses incurred unless otherwise agreed to in advance for specific activities.
- Conflict of Interest. Contractor does not have, or anticipate having, any interest 6. in real property, investments, business interests in or income from sources which would provide Contractor or his spouse with personal financial gain as a result of any recommendation, advice or any other action taken by Contractor during the rendition of services under this Agreement.
- Termination of Agreement. Either School or Contractor may terminate this 7. Agreement at any time for any reason upon written notice. In the event of early termination, Contractor shall be paid for satisfactory work performed prior to the date of termination. The School may then proceed with the work in any manner the School deems appropriate.
- Indemnity. The Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the 8. School and its agents, employees, Board of Directors, members of the Board

of Directors, from and against claims, damages, losses, and expenses (included, but not limited to attorney's fees and costs including fees of consultants) arising out of or resulting from performance of the contract (including, but not limited to) the Contractor's use of the site; the Contractor's completion of the duties under the contract; injury to or death of persons or damage to property or delay or damage to the School, its agents, employees, Board of Directors, members of the Board of Directors, for any act, omission, negligence, or willful misconduct of the Contractor or their respective agents, subcontractors, employees, material or equipment suppliers, invitees, or licensees. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity, which would otherwise exist as to a party, person, or entity described in this paragraph.

- 9. <u>Independent Contractor Status</u>. While engaged in carrying out the terms and conditions of the Contract, the Contractor is an independent contractor, and not an officer, employee, agent, partner, or joint venturer of the School.
- 10. <u>Worker's Compensation Insurance</u>. Contractor agrees to provide all necessary workers' compensation insurance of Contractor's employees, if any, at Contractors own cost and expense.
- 11. <u>Taxes</u>. Contractor agrees that Contractor has no entitlement or any future work from the School or to any employment or fringe benefits from the School. Payments to the Contractor pursuant to this Agreement will be reported to Federal and State taxing authorities as required. School will not withhold any money from compensation payable to Contractor. In particular, School will not withhold FICA (social security); state or federal unemployment insurance contributions, state or federal income tax or disability insurance. Contractor is independently responsible for the payment of all applicable taxes.
- 12. <u>Assignment</u>. The Contractor shall not assign or transfer by operation of law or otherwise any or all of its rights, burdens, duties or obligations without the prior written consent of the School.
- 13. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision hereof.
- 14. <u>Amendments</u>. The terms of the Contract Documents shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented or amended in any manner whatsoever except by written agreement signed by both parties.
- 15. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California and venue shall be in the appropriate Superior Court of California.
- 16. <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and shall be binding upon the Contractor and the School and their respective successors and assigns.
- 17. <u>Written Notice</u>. Written notice shall be deemed to have been duly served if delivered in person to the individual or member of the company for whom it was intended, or if delivered at or sent by registered or certified mail to the last business address known to the person who gives notice.

- 18. <u>Non-Discrimination.</u> It is the policy of the School that there shall be no discrimination against any of Contractor's prospective or active employees because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, sex or religious creed. Therefore, the Contractor agrees to comply with applicable federal and California laws.
- 19. <u>Compliance with Law.</u> Each and every provision of law and clause required by law to be inserted into this Agreement shall be deemed to be inserted herein and this Agreement shall be read and enforced as though it were included therein. Contractor agrees that it shall comply with all legal requirements for the performance of its duties under this Agreement and that failure to do so shall constitute material breach.
- 20. <u>Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement is intended by the Parties as the final expression of their agreement with respect to such terms as are included herein and as the complete and exclusive statement of its terms and may not be contradicted by evidence of any prior agreement or of a contemporaneous oral agreement, not explained or supplemented by evidence of consistent additional terms.
- 21. <u>Execution of Other Documents</u>. The parties to the Agreement shall cooperate fully in the execution of any and all other documents and in the completion of any additional actions that may be necessary or appropriate to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.
- 22. <u>Execution in Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts such that the signatures may appear on separate signature pages. A copy, or an original, with all signatures appended together, shall be deemed a fully executed agreement.
- 23. <u>Board Approval</u>. The effectiveness of this Agreement is contingent upon the approval of the Excel Academy Charter School Board of Directors if required by Board Policy.
