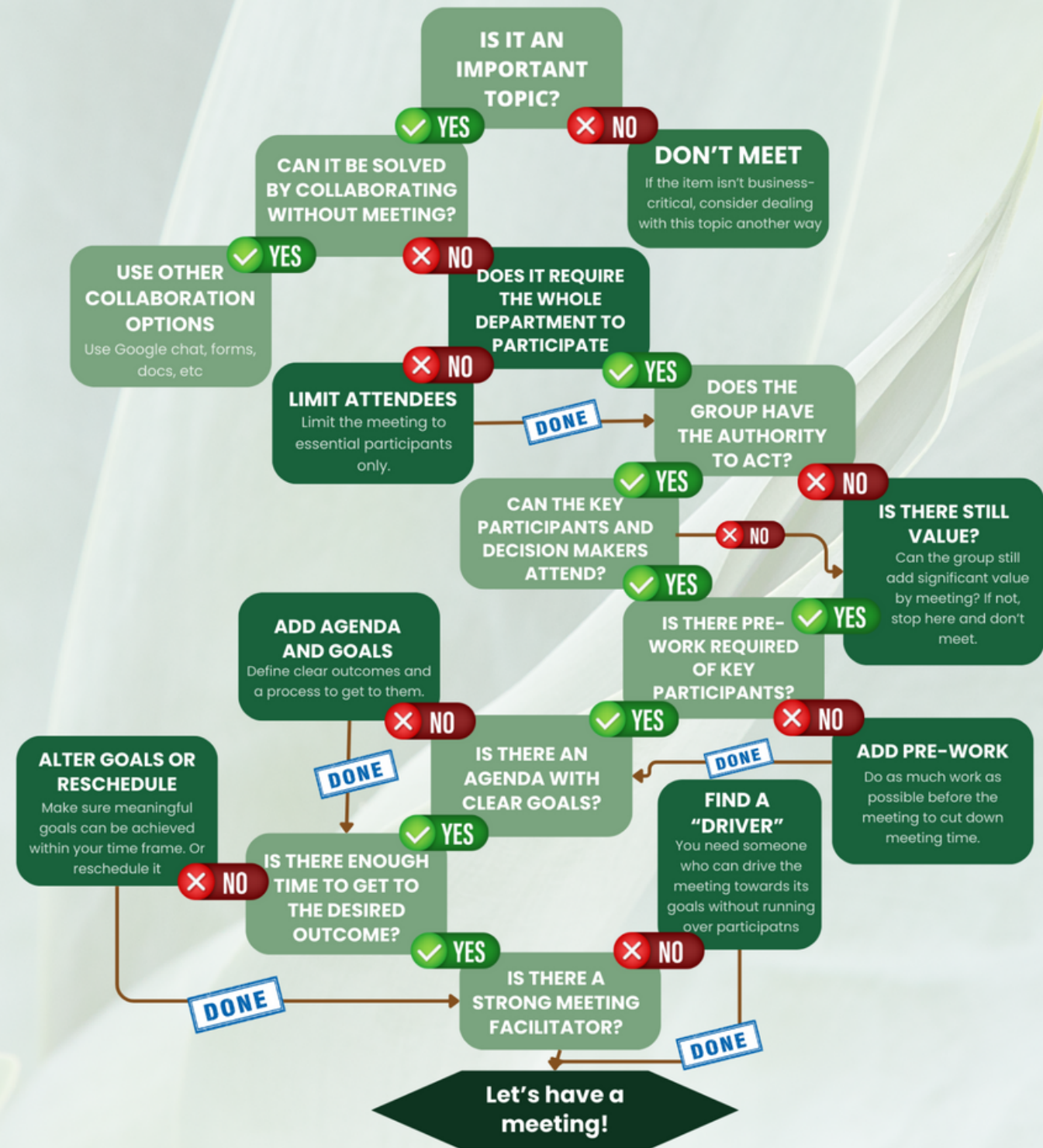
Flow of Information



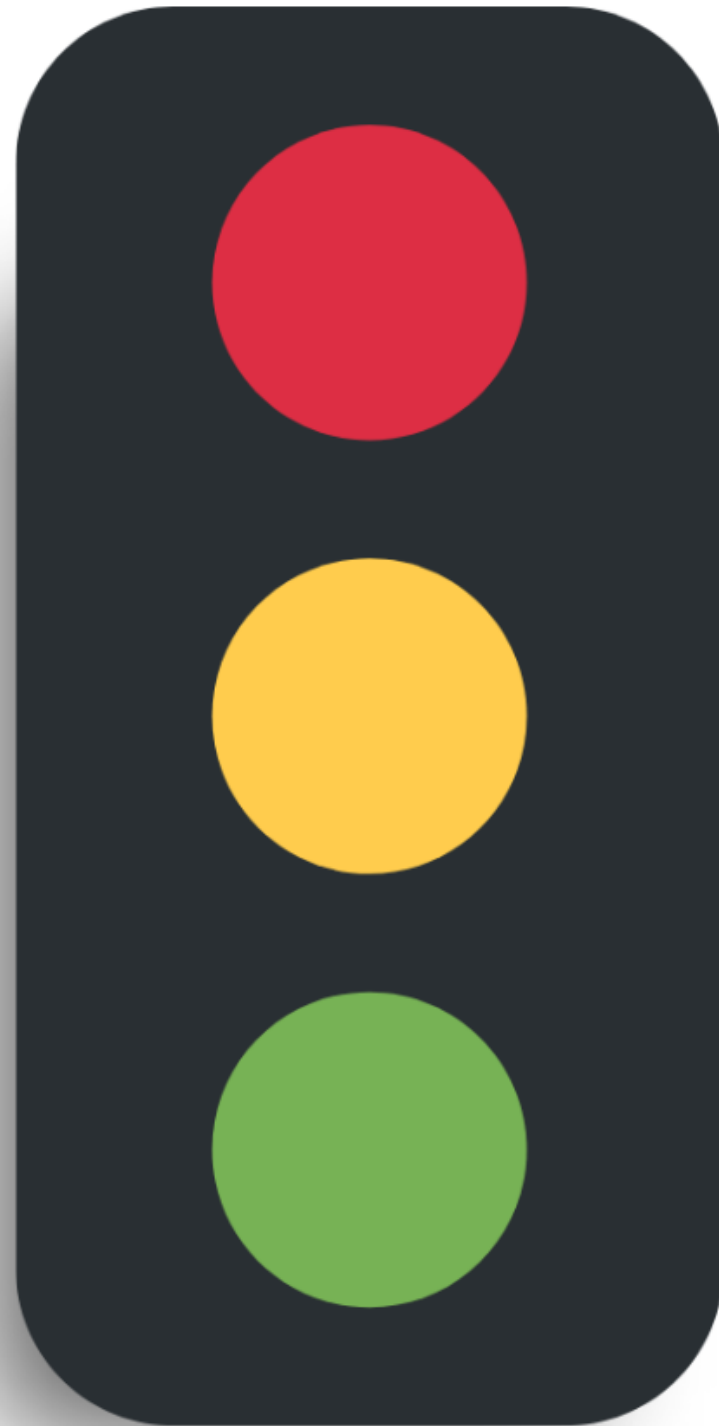
Should We Have a Meeting?
