"Oral Communications" is set aside for members of the audience to raise issues that are not specifically on the agenda. However, due to public meeting laws, the Board can only listen to your issue, not respond or take action. These presentations are limited to three (3) minutes and total time allotted to non-agenda items will not exceed twenty-five (25) minutes. The Board may give direction to staff to respond to your concern or you may be offered the option of returning with a citizen-requested item.
 3. You may also complete a "Request to Speak" form to address the Board on Agenda items. With regard to such agenda items, you may specify that agenda item on your "Request to Speak" form and you will be given an opportunity to speak for up to three (3) minutes before the item, and total time allocated to agenda items will not exceed six (6) minutes for a discussion item and nine (9) minutes per vote item.
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4. When addressing the Board, speakers are requested to state their name and adhere to the time limits set forth.
5. Any public records relating to an agenda item for an open session of the Board which are distributed to all, or a majority of all, of the Board members shall be available for public inspection at 5440 Valley Circle Blvd., Woodland Hills, California, 91367.

Consent Agenda: All matters listed under the consent agenda are considered by the Board to be routine and will be approved/enacted by the Board in one motion in the form listed below. Unless specifically requested by a Board member for further discussion or removed from the agenda, there will be no discussion of these items prior to the Board votes on them. There being no further business to be transacted, and upon motion duly made, seconded and approved, the meeting was adjourned at 3:15 PM.

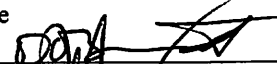

CDO Academic Decathlon Scrimmage

Dear Academic Decathlon Coach,

You are cordially invited to attend the annual Canyon del Oro Academic Decathlon Scrimmage, which will take place on **Friday and Saturday, December 7 and 8, 2018**. I hope that this scrimmage will be an invaluable tool in helping to train your team for the regional competition and to aid you in determining the make-up of your team. Please read the following information carefully.

Teams: The scrimmage is open to up to 20 schools, divided into two divisions: the Arizona Division, consisting of teams from Arizona, and the National Division, consisting of teams from outside of Arizona. Each team may bring up to 18 students. We will be using the official USAD Round 1, v2 tests, which may be distinct from the Round 1 tests given elsewhere.

Prizes: For each subject there will be certificates for the top **five** students in each GPA category. Furthermore, the top three overall (ten event) scores in each GPA category will receive medals. The top three teams at the Super Quiz relay will each receive a plaque. The three highest scoring teams overall will win trophies.

Tentative Competition Schedule: The CDO Scrimmage will follow a schedule similar to that of the Arizona regional and state competitions.

Financial and Judging Support: The cost of the scrimmage will be \$25 per student. If you cannot provide the requisite number of judges, this will increase to \$30 per student. **The full amount (or a PO for this amount) is due by Friday, November 16, 2018.** This will cover the cost of dinner on Friday as well as the costs of judges' meals, trophies, plaques, certificates, medals, answer forms, copying costs, etc. **Any team paying after the November 16 deadline must pay a \$5 per student additional fee.** Please start the paperwork for your payment immediately! In the past I have had to wait until January for some payments, and the caterer is not sympathetic about late payments. **Each team must furnish at least 2 essay judges, 2 speech judges and 2 interview judges, more if possible.** If you will not be able to supply the judges, you will have to pay an additional amount for each student, as outlined above.

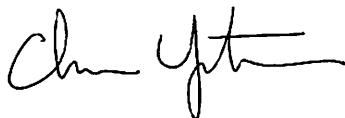
Testing Only Option: Those coaches who want their teams to have the opportunity of taking the scrimmage tests, but don't want the cost or bother of providing judges, can choose the option of having their teams take the tests only. The tests will be administered on Saturday, December 2, starting at 8:00AM in a specially designated testing room at CDO. The cost is only \$5 per student, and students are still eligible to win prizes. However, these students will not be able to participate in the speech, interview or essay competition. Please use the attached form to let me know if your team wishes to use the "Test Only" option.

Super Quiz Relay: We will have a collaborative Super Quiz Relay. All three Varsity students from each team will take the floor, and answer 12 questions, 2 from each academic area (except math), spending 10 seconds discussing the responses with each other before time is called. All three Scholastic students, and then all three Honor students will follow them in subsequent rounds. Extra students will be able to form overflow teams. The results from the Relay will NOT be used as part of the overall team score; however, we will award a plaque to the top three teams in the Relay.

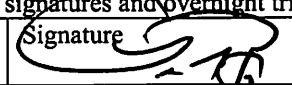

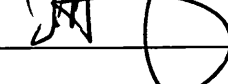

Varsity Dance Guard Request for Out-of-State travel to Las Vegas, NV for the WGI West Power Regional.

Rationale:

Winter Guard International is the international circuit that the Varsity and Junior Varsity Dance Guard teams compete in. The Varsity team is at a high enough level to compete at the Western Power Regional (which is equivalent to the West Coast championships). Last year the Western Power Regional was in San Diego, and the ECR Varsity Dance Guard won 3rd place overall after competing in prelims, semi-finals, and finals (an incredible accomplishment). We would like to continue to compete again at the Western Power Regional this year, which happens to be in Las Vegas at the Thomas and Mack Center. This trip will be similar in cost to the trip we took to San Diego last year.

Going on a trip like this gives the students real-life experience that they can not learn in a classroom. They work hard as a team, bond as a team, and succeed as a team. This trip will be a formative experience for these students. Competing in competitions of this level promote the ECRCHS brand as one of the best on the West Coast, and in the nation.

The students will leave at 6th period on Friday 3/22/19 and will return on Sunday 3/24/19 afternoon. The students will sign a contract that they promise to be in school on Monday 3/25/19 and that they will have all their school work complete (a 5 hour car ride there and back plus down time at the hotel give the students plenty of time to work on school assignments). If they do not, they will not be allowed to compete in our final competition, which is Southern California championships.

Although the regional is not until March, the sign-up date is 9/24/18, and the events fill up on the day of registration.

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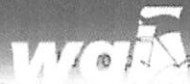
