Dear Parents/Guardians:

The safety and well-being of students and staff remain my top priority. As you know, we sent out a message earlier this evening reporting the discovery of a threatening message on the stall in the girls' restroom. The message was barely legible on the stall and read, "School shooting this Friday 1/18". We checked every bathroom on campus and have not received any other reports of threats. The incident was discussed with school police and a report was filed. According to School Police, there is no indication that the message poses a credible threat, but they are continuing to investigate. Additional security/law enforcement officers have also been requested to our campus.

We recognize that just like adults, our students may have questions or concerns about the safety of our school. We encourage everyone at school to always be vigilant and 'If you see something, say something.'

We again urge you to speak to your child/children about the implications of joking or making false statements relating to campus safety. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact us at 818-595-7500.
