HB 981 – Local Schools Open Enrollment Study

Status: Passed House

Summary: Directs a formal study on open-

enrollment policies within LEAs, allowing students to attend schools outside their assigned zones.

Impact: While many LEAs already allow transfers, a statewide policy could bring greater consistency and clarity to enrollment practices

S442 – Parents Protection Act

Purpose Presenter Time

Status: Passed Senate

Summary:

Ensures a parent's refusal to affirm a child's gender identity is not considered abuse or neglect

Prevents discrimination in adoption/foster placements based on gender identity beliefs

Impact: May influence school-

family interactions and expectations around student identity policies in charter schools.

HB 886 - AEDs and CPR in Public Schools

Status: Passed House

Summary: Requires AEDs on-site and CPR training for staff in public schools.

Impact: Charter schools must plan for equipment purchase, staff training, and compliance.

New Mandates Affecting Charter Schools Statewide

- Cell Phone-Free Instructional Policies Required: Mandates PSUs, including charters, to restrict cell phone use during instructional time.
- Mandatory Social Media & Mental Health Literacy Instruction K-12: Requires instruction on social media safety, addiction, bullying, and mental health.
- Suicide & Crisis Lifeline Info on Student ID Cards: Requires Lifeline info on student ID cards issued by charters.
- Dyslexia Screening for Early Learners: Requires charters with early grades to conduct dyslexia screening.
- **Meal Debt Equity Policy:** Requires all PSUs, including charters, to serve the same meals regardless of debt status.
- Statewide Efforts to Ease Hiring of School Psychologists: Charters benefit from systemwide easing of hiring requirements.
