PROPOSITION 1

Shall the district be authorized to levy in the **Arlee Elementary School District** the sum of THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000) per year for TEN (10) years and being approximately 8.32 mills for the purpose of purchasing, renting, repairing and maintaining technological equipment, including computers and computer network access, cloud computing services for technology infrastructure, platform, software, network, storage, security, data, database, test environment curriculum, or desktop virtualization purposes, including any subscription or any license-based or pay-per-use service that is accessed over the internet or other remote network to meet the district's information technology and other needs, and the associated technical training for school district personnel?

Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$11.23, on a home with a market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$22.46, and on a home with a market value of \$600,000 by approximately \$67.39. An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs.
