**Number of Seniors: 116**

**Number on Track for College Acceptance:** All 116 Seniors received a four-year school acceptance.

## **FAFSA Completion**

# Scholarships

Seniors have collectively so far submitted almost 400 scholarships. These scholarships have all required at least one essay, so they are not “easy” sign-up scholarships.
