

- 1 Eligibility Completed, pending parent consent

SERVICES/DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Elementary, Middle and High School

- Specialized Academic Instruction: ES/MS- Building session continuity, held weekly; HS- sessions consistently held since 8/29/22
- **Speech Therapy:** sessions consistently held for all students since 9/22/22
- **Counseling:** services held since 9/6/22
- 1 Eligibility Evaluation completed, 1 started
- 6 Triennial Evaluations started
- CDE Small LEA Policy and Procedures self review: 22/25 Compliance tests met, with support from EDC SELPA.

High School: 15 (14 SAI, 2 SLP and 5 counseling)


