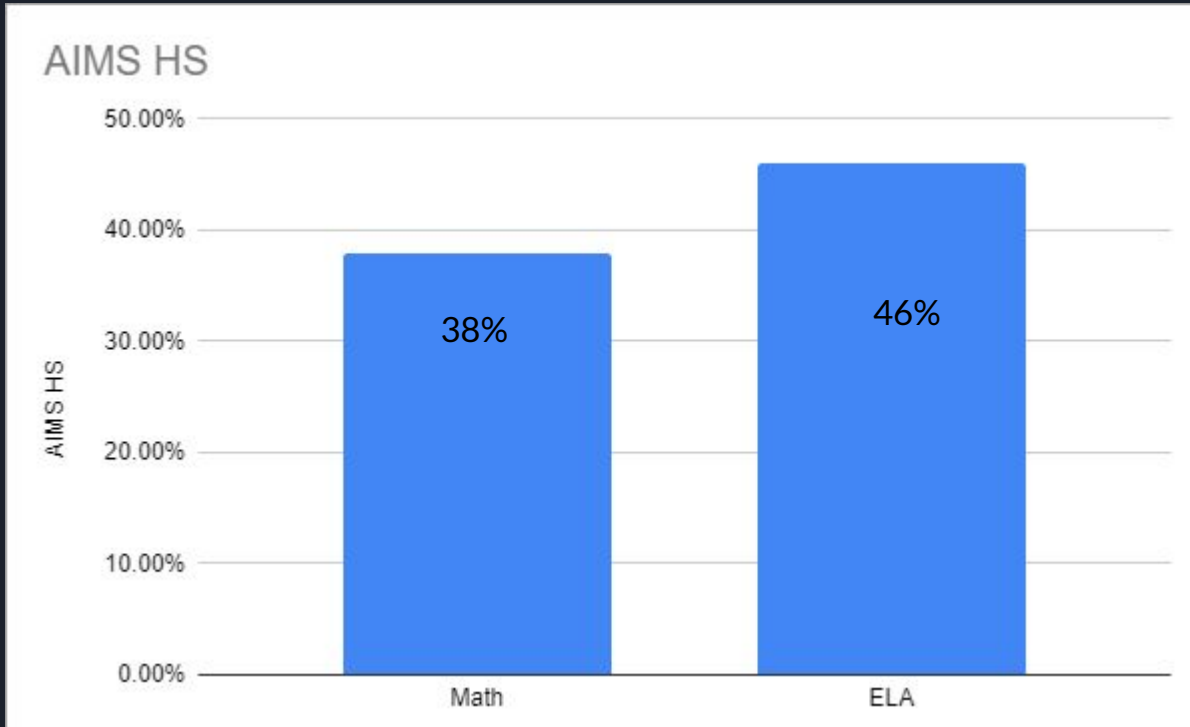
2023-2024 SBAC Results - AIPCS II

2023-2024 SBAC Analysis AIPCS II

AIPCS II has the highest averages amongst all the schools. With Math and ELA above 60% proficiency rate, they continue to outperform the other schools. Despite the yielding the highest averages, AIPCS II was still able to increase from the previous year. There was a 7% increase in ELA and a 3% increase in Math. AIPCS II continues to yield impressive averages, while still making minor improvements.



2023-2024 SBAC Analysis AIMS MS

AIMS MS landed in the middle among all the AIMS district schools. ELA is the better subject between the two and this is consistent across all the schools. Additionally compared to last year, AIMS MS's ELA scores increase significantly by 5%. However, on the other hand, math saw a slight decrease of 1%. Relative to California averages, AIMS MS outperforms the state's averages for both subjects. Math sits at 34.62% and ELA at 46.66% which is much lower than the current AIMS MS averages.

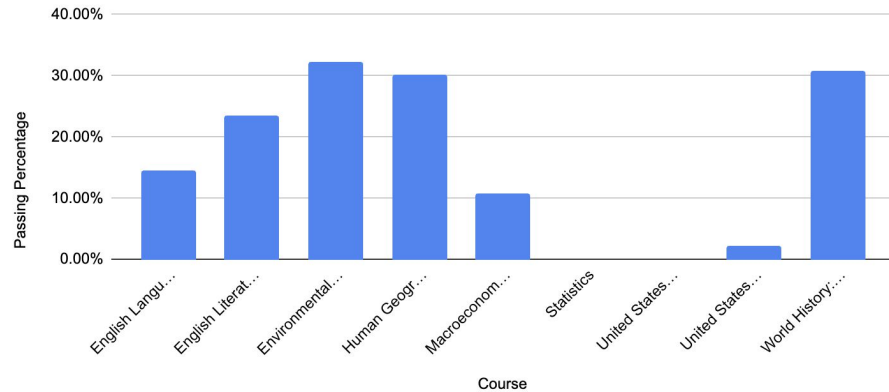


2023-2024 SBAC Analysis AIMS HS

This year AIMS HS did not perform as well as the other schools within our district. Furthermore, there is a larger drop off compared to the previous year. Last year, Math percentages were at 58% and ELA at 67%. However this year, we see both subjects were not able to reach 50%. With Math dropping 20% and ELA dropping 21%, this is such a large drop off from the previous year. However that said, AIMS HS math outperforms the state average (27.35%). But is unable to eclipse California's ELA averages (55.41%). Within HS, only 11th graders take the test, so that must also be taken into account.

AP SCORES Analysis 2023-2024

This year's total percentage pass rate seems to be hovering around the same percentages of last year with this year being 20.18% and last year being 20.9%. However, the difference is the highest pass percentage this year was in math (excluding art) and last year it was Chinese. Furthermore, we see there is a significantly larger amount of students taking AP tests this year than last. With the large increase, it may be a reassuring sign that there was a consistent performance across the different subject matter. Additionally, this year we see our worst performances among the science classes. Biology, chemistry, environmental science, and statistics sit at the bottom only yielding single digit pass rates. Conversely, we see the history classes averages surpass the total passage percentage. Typically hovering around 25-35% pass rate.
