There being no further business to be transacted, and upon motion duly made, seconded and approved, the meeting was adjourned at 4:02 PM.

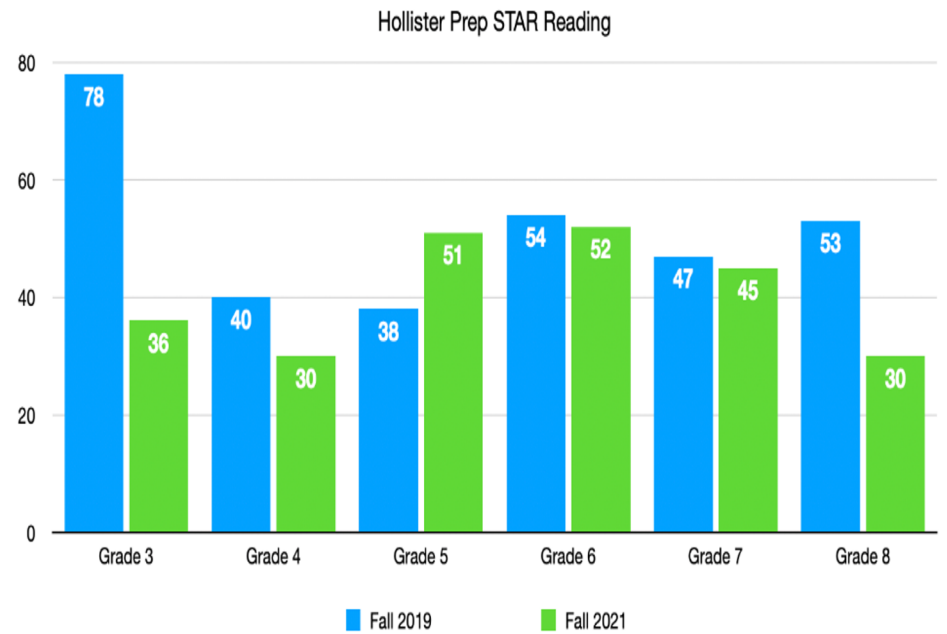
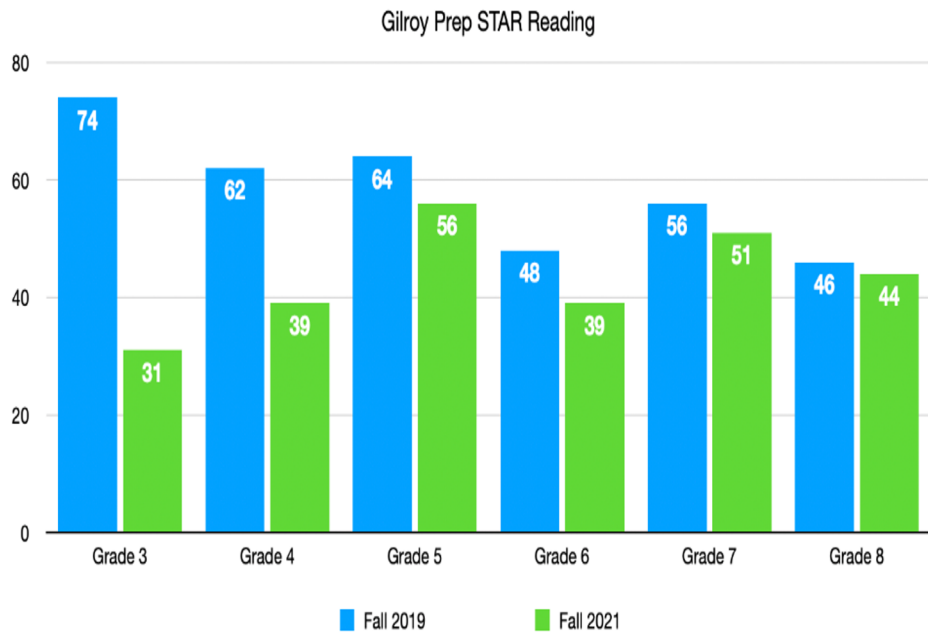

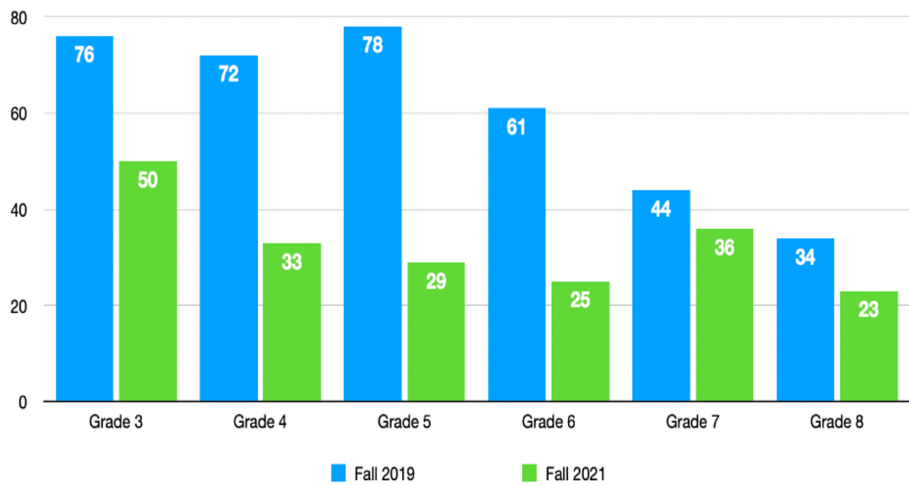

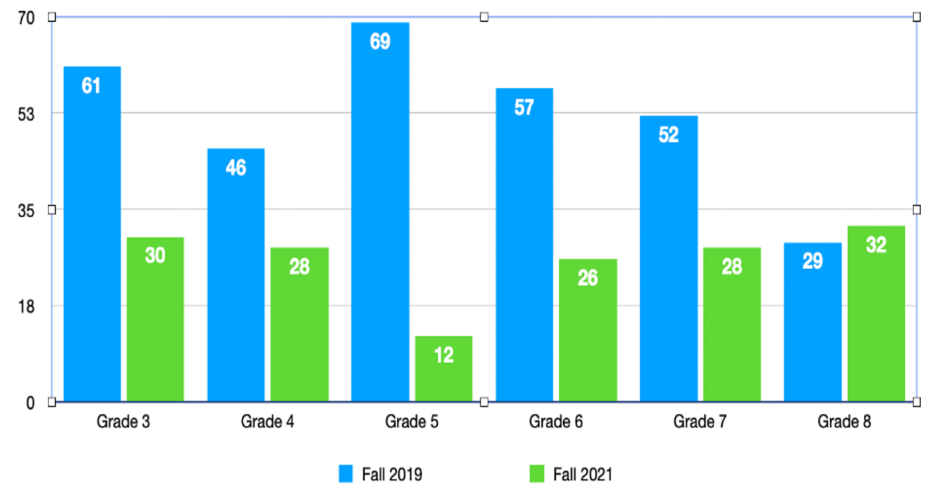


Percentiles

Gilroy Prep STAR Math

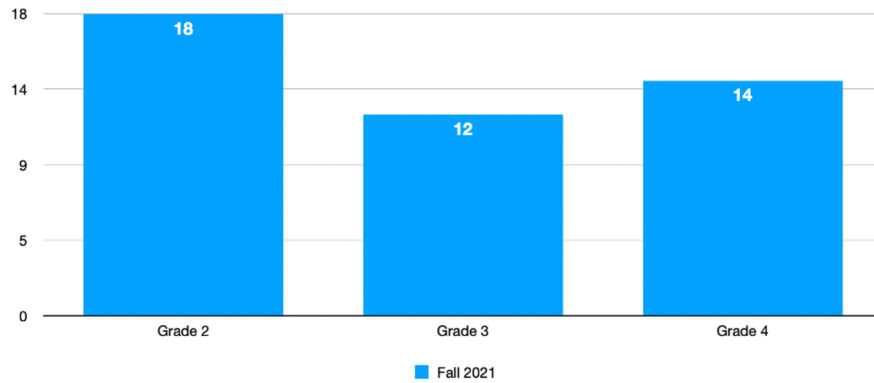


Hollister Prep STAR Math

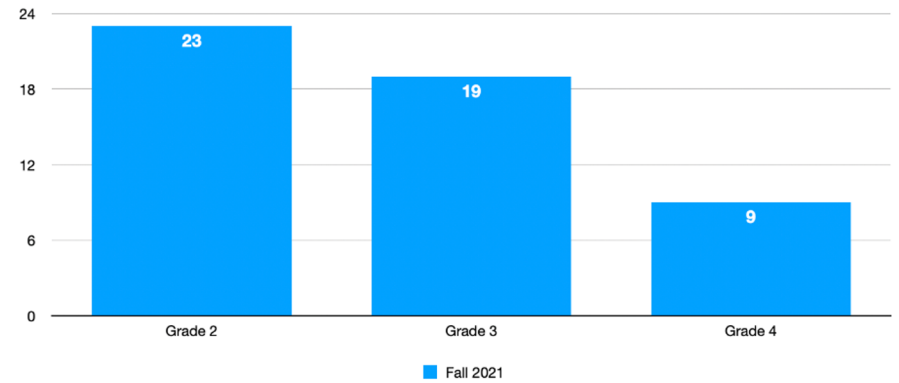


Current Percentiles at WPS

What should our greenlight metrics for 21-22 be:

1. 5% of students in levels 1 and 2 move up a level each unit
1. Percentage of students at level 3 and 4 increases by 5% each unit
1. We hit 60% on SBAC on math and 70% on SBAC in ELA
1. Student growth percentiles exceed 60% on average
1. Students gain 3 percentile points on average each unit
