Background

The operations team has been working diligently at Hayward Collegiate to make sure that students and staff are safe and healthy. One major component of that is upgrading the old HVAC system on one wing and installing a new HVAC system in the social hall and other wing of classrooms. We have been working with a project manager, Mary Bates, to ensure that we stay in compliance and get the proper quotes. Please see her request to go with Bay Area Climate below. It is important to get the HVAC system working properly with cooling and heating so that our students and staff are in a comfortable setting for learning. This past week, during the heatwave, we had classrooms reaching 97 degrees and had to move to minimum days for the rest of the week, to avoid heat exhaustion.

Here are the three HVAC replacement bids.

- 1 Bay Area Climate Control = \$61,900
- 2 BA Morrison = \$145,517
- 3 City Mechanical = \$118,615

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board authorize the CEO to execute the agreement with Bay Area Climate.
