 - **TN Ready Participation Percentages for KMCE, KMAE, KMCM, KMAM, KMCH which included Reading, Math, Science and Social Studies**
- **2022-2023 Academic Programming**
 - **Academic Program Focus**
 - KIPP Memphis will use aligned instructional tools to ensure a coherent academic program.
 - The Managing Director of Teaching & Learning will support the PLC and Instructional Coaches regarding norming and early literacy
 - The Academics Team will work with the Data & Innovation Team to create protocols that all schools will use.
 - **Textbooks:** KIPP will purchase books for all K-12 grade KIPPsters in an effort to enhance their learning experience.
 - **Promethean Boards:** KIPP will purchase Promethean Boards to enhance the learning experience of our KIPPsters.
