#### **HVAC Preventative Maintenance Addendum Request**

The vendor Emcor, which services Cadence and Nellis, wants to increase their quarterly pricing for each campus.

"The minor increases reflect minor increases to account for material and labor fluctuations over the past two years. We do our best to delay price increases as long as possible, but it has become necessary for us to do so."

Cadence: Emcor wants to increase their annual cost from \$34,380 to \$35,520.

**Nellis:** Emcor wants to increase their annual cost from \$15,048 to \$16,248.

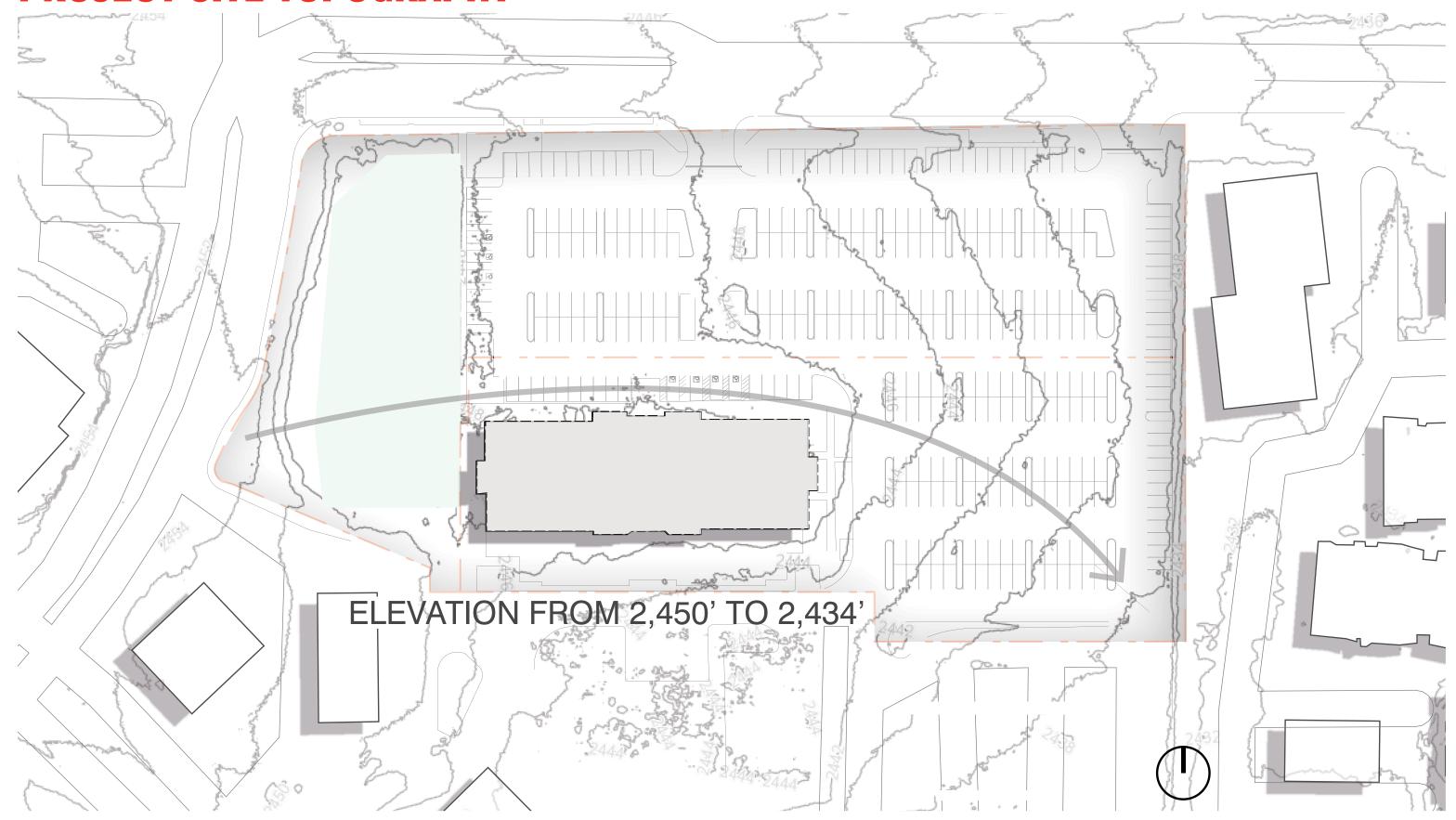

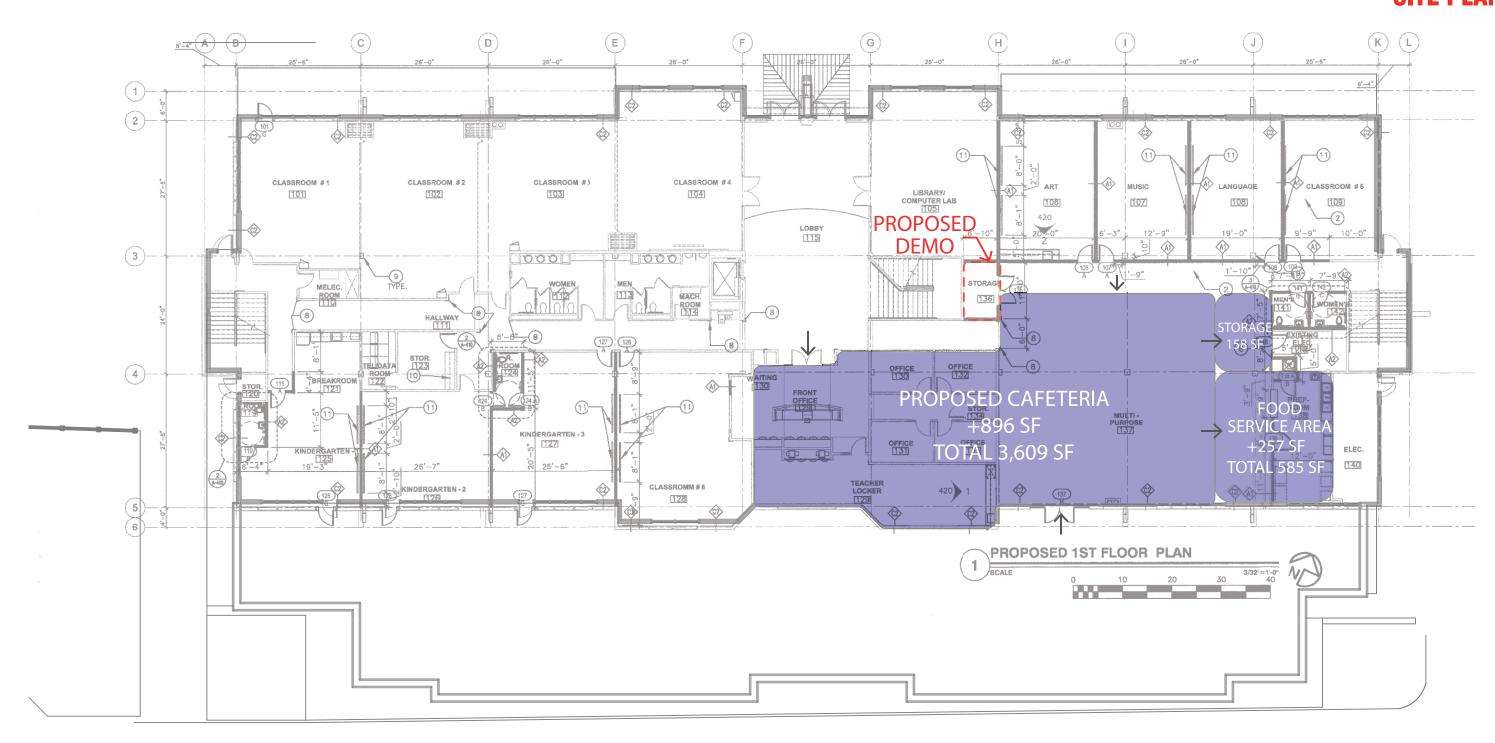

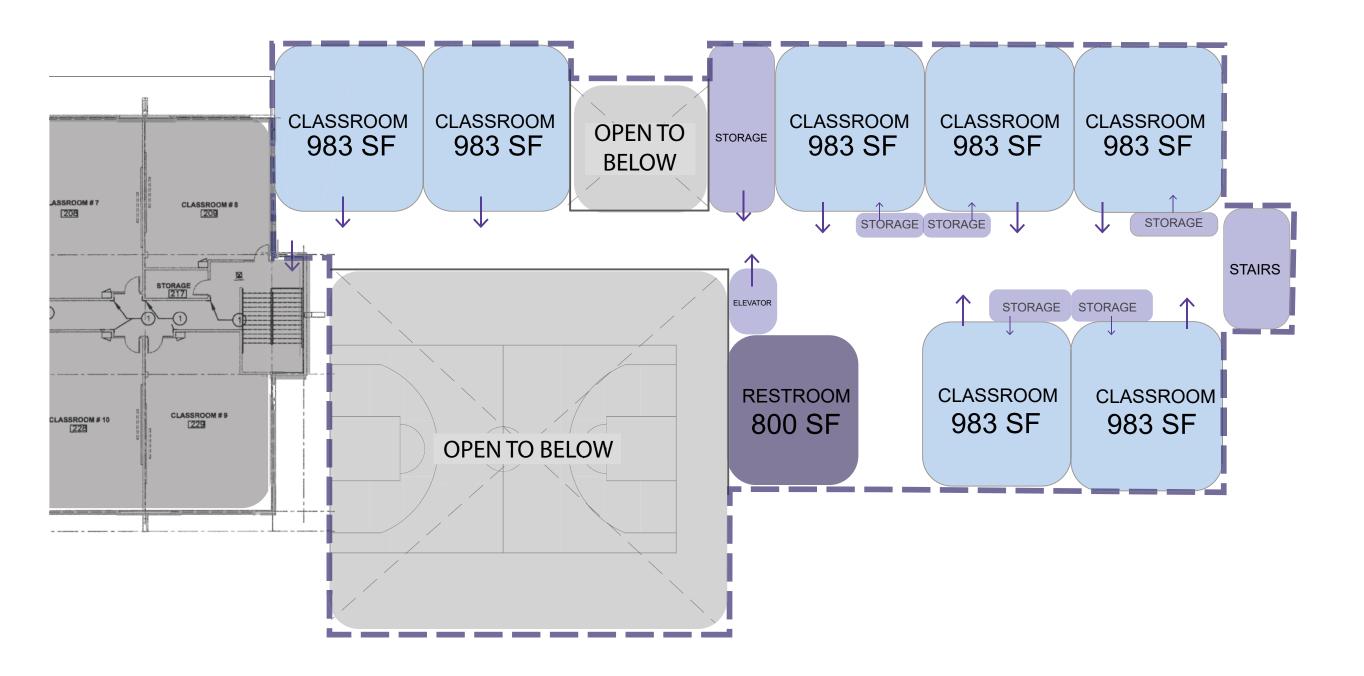
# **OPTION 1** FLOOR PLAN - LEVEL 1

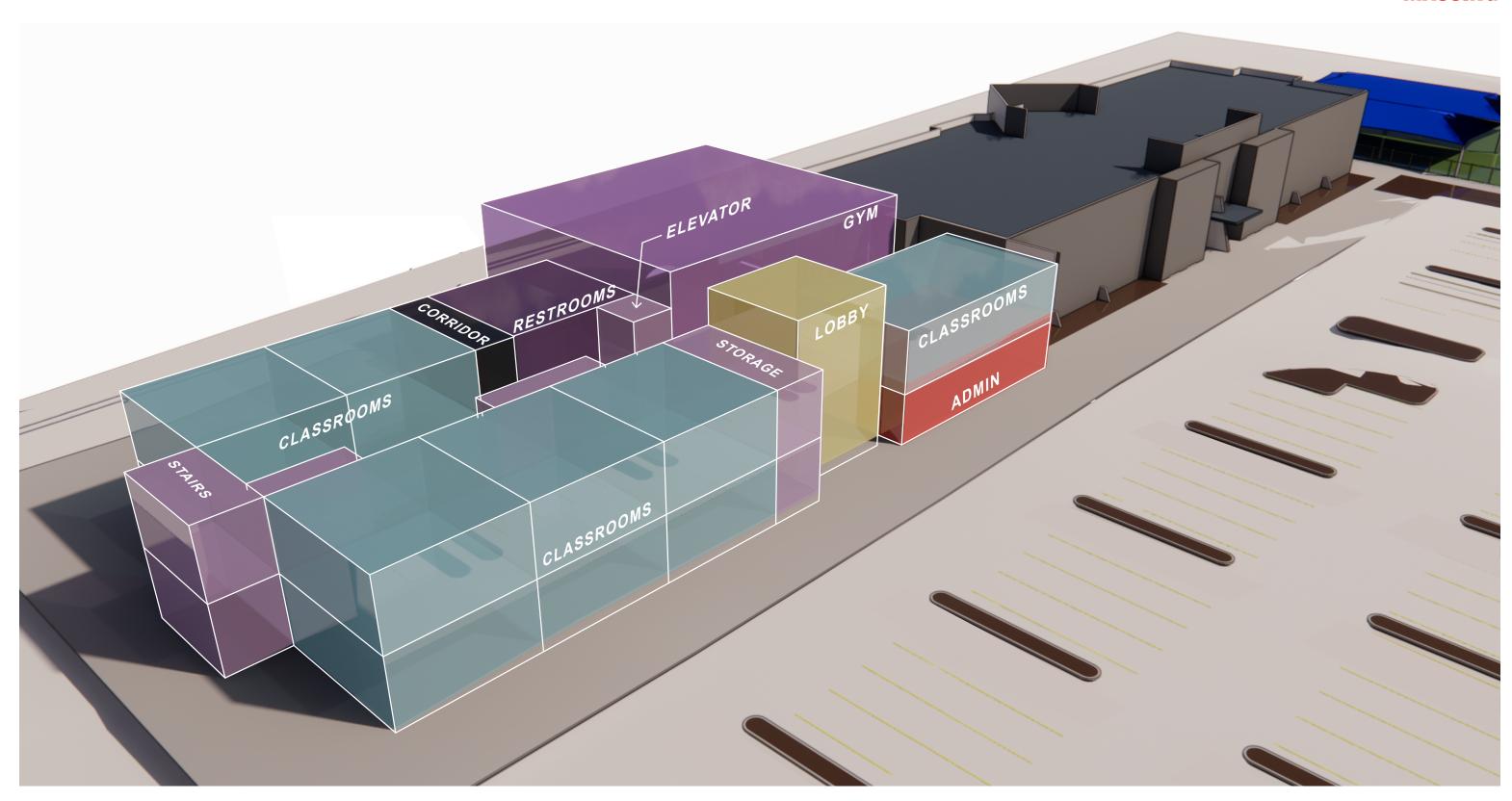
# **OPTION 1** FLOOR PLAN - LEVEL 2

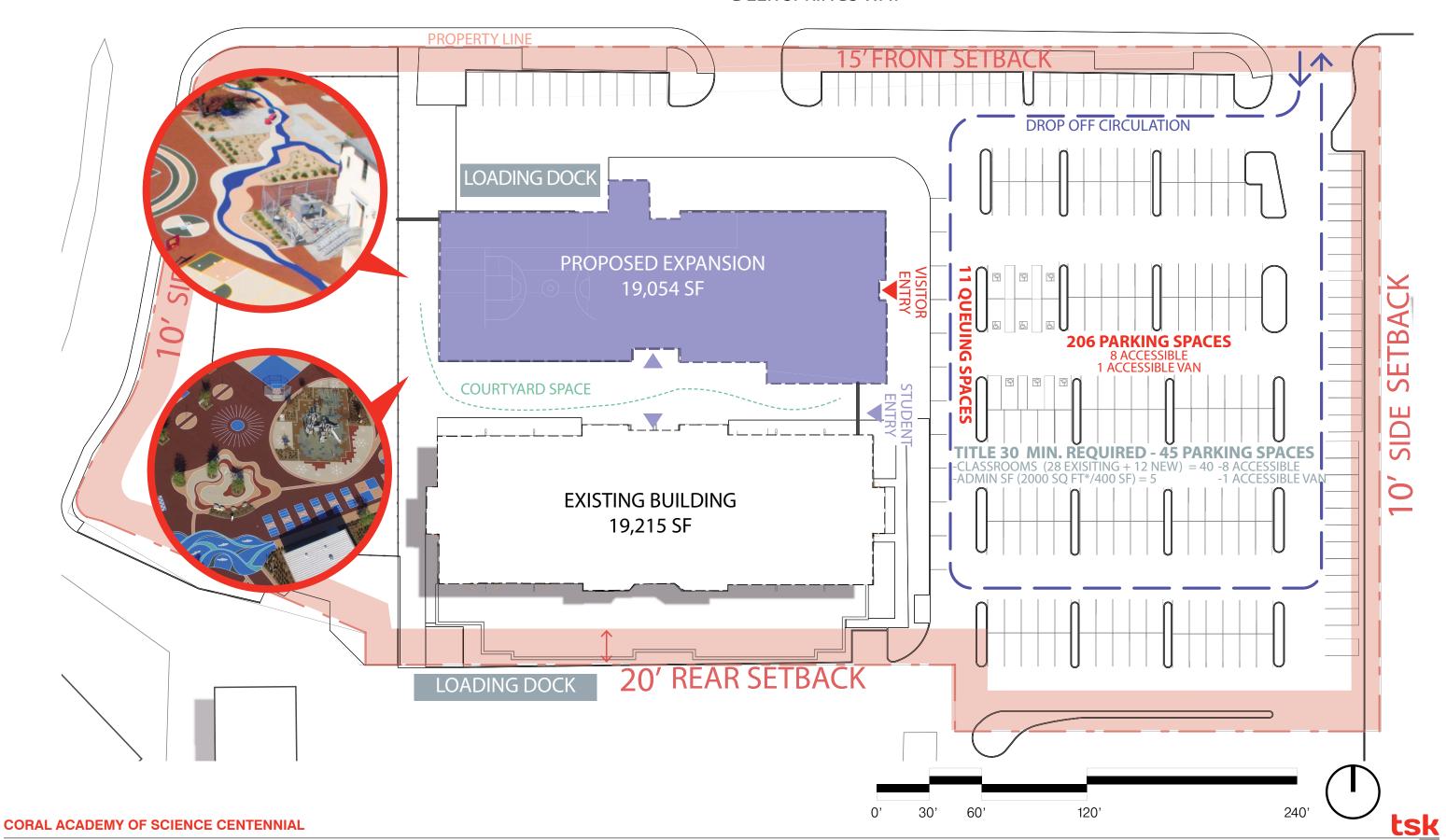

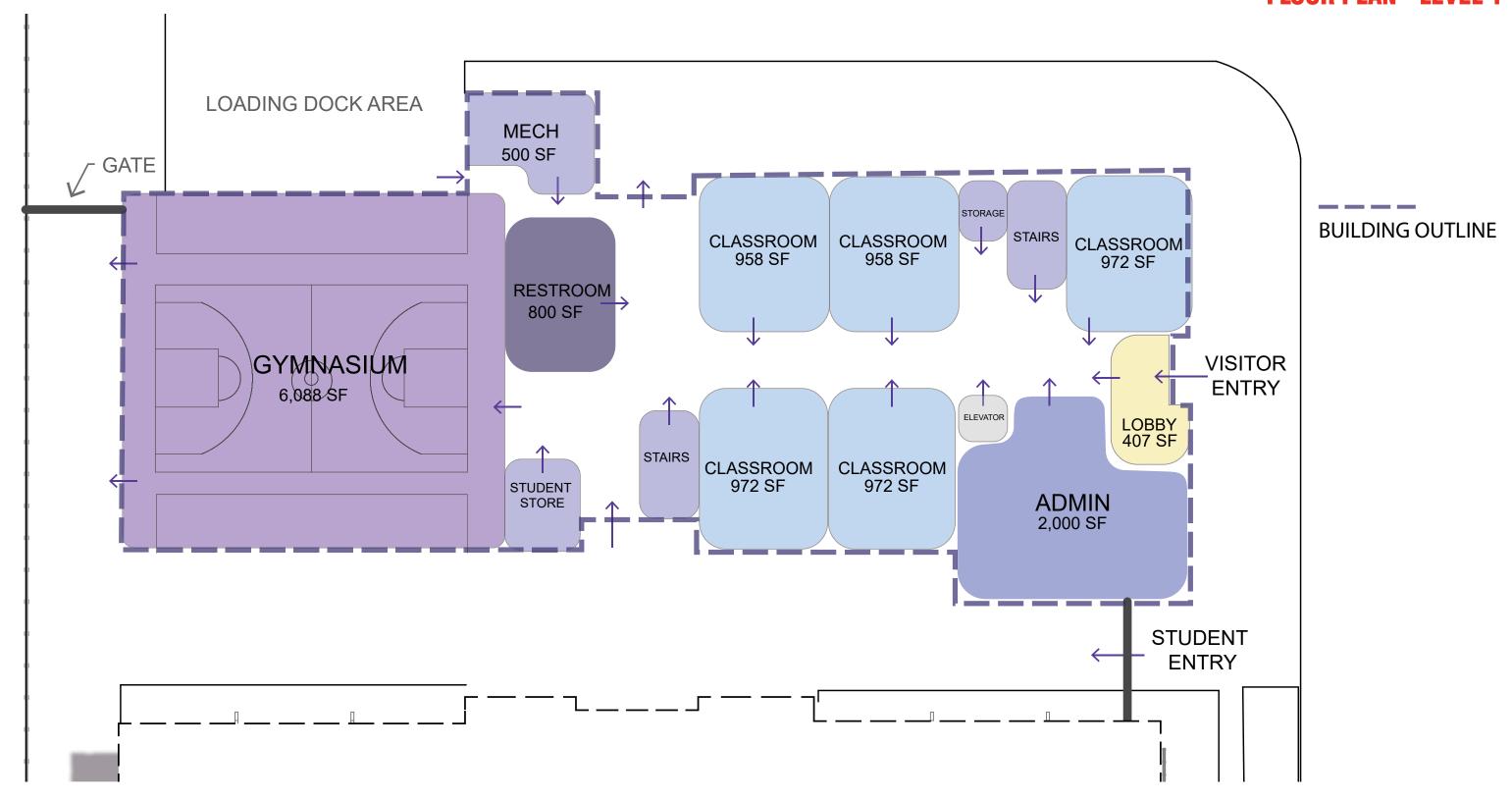

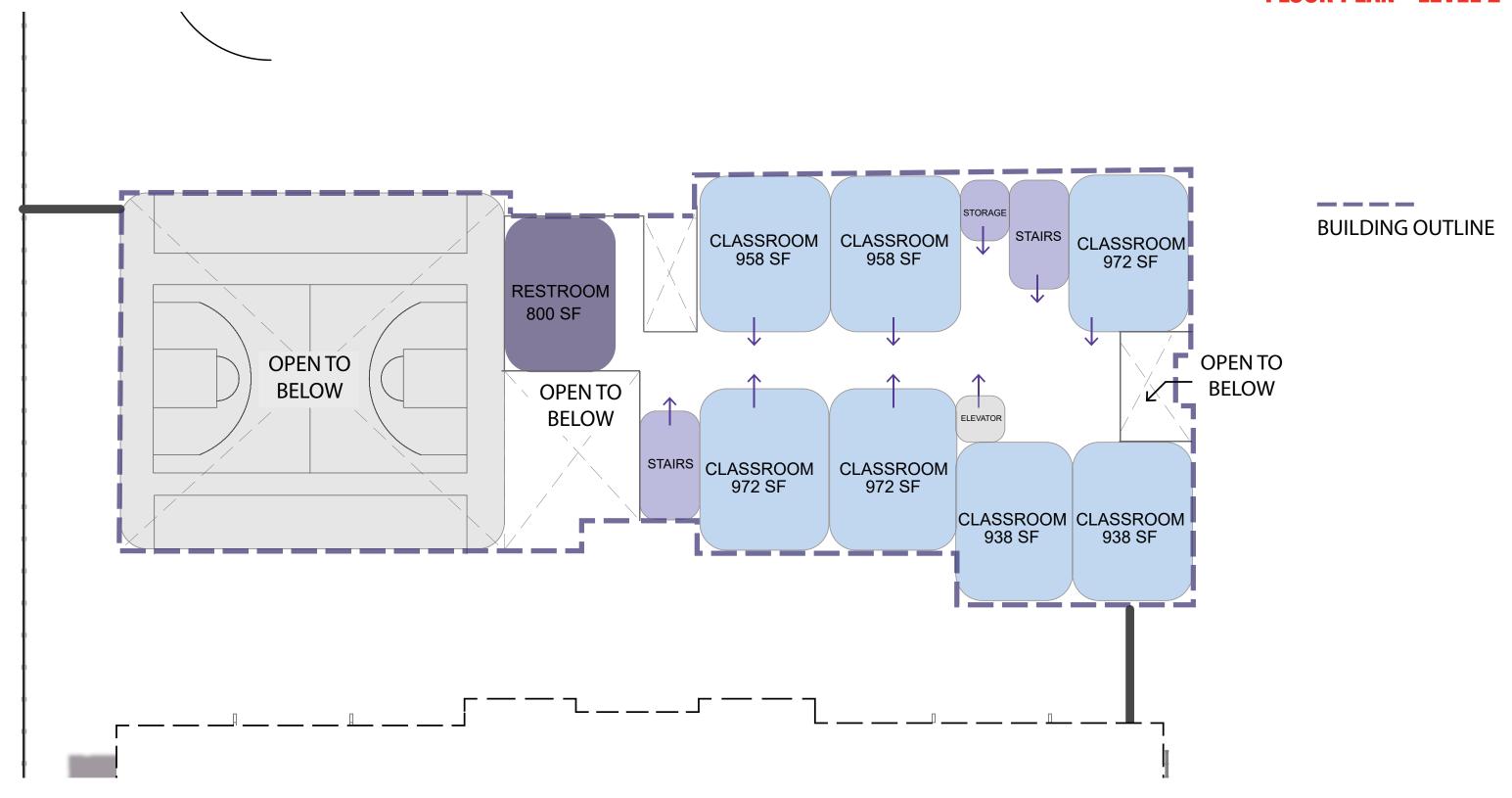


# **OPTION 2A** FLOOR PLAN - LEVEL 1



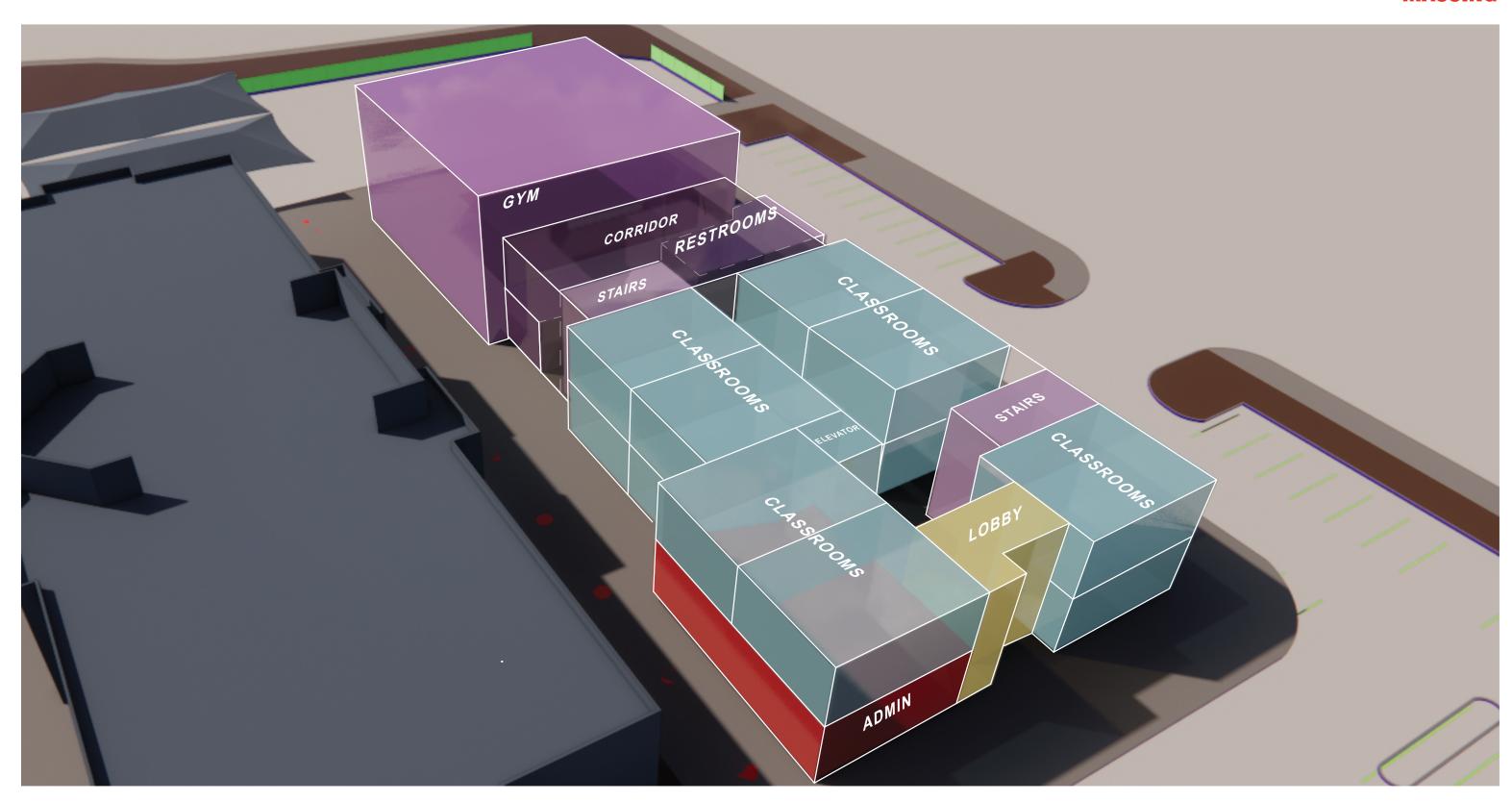
