<sup>\*</sup>If a student with a disability of any age is removed from school premises, suspended, expelled, or permanently expelled for any behavior for more than 10 cumulative days, the school in which the student is enrolled must make available to the student a free appropriate public education in compliance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). Although this provision has existed in federal law for many years, the state legislature appears to have incorporated it for emphasis. Schools must comply with this and other provisions of the IDEA with respect to notice, determining whether a removal constitutes a change of placement, conducting a manifestation determination, and other requirements in connection with any disciplinary removal of a pupil with a disability.
