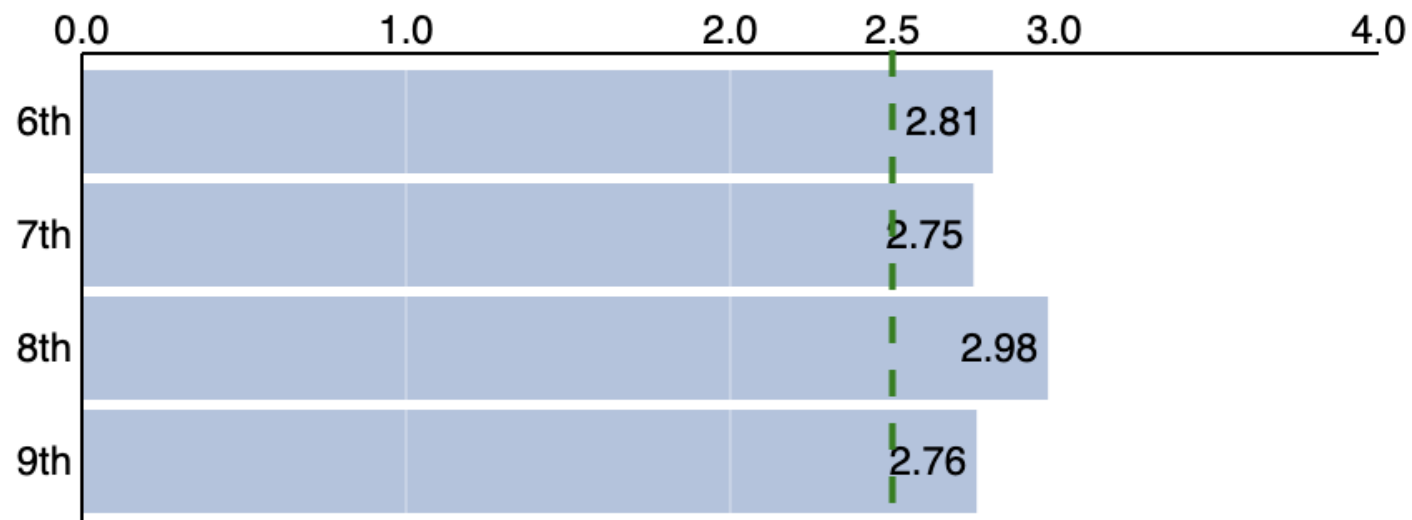

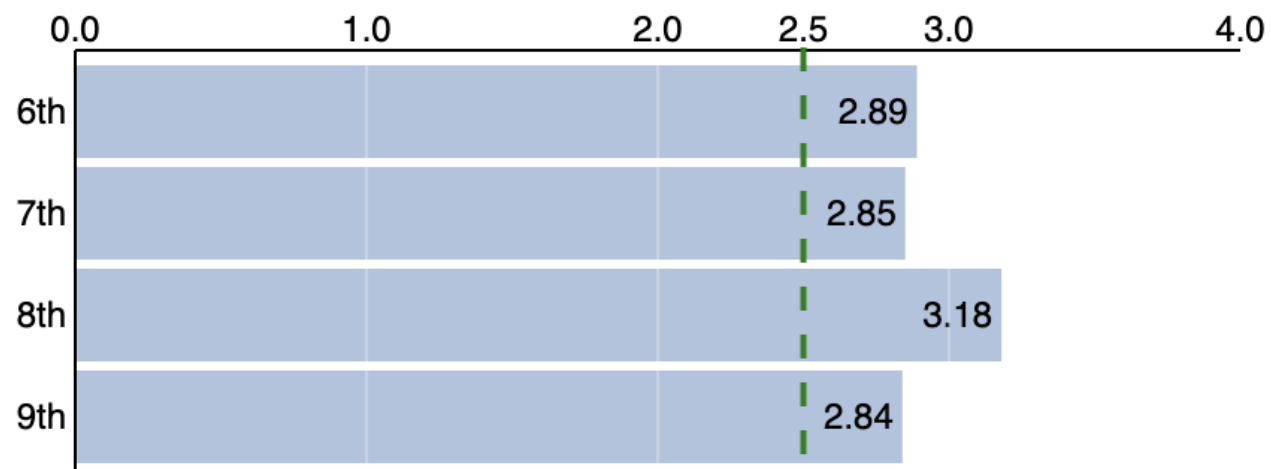
# GPA Data (April)
