- · Some subjects have begun aligning to curriculum units.
- Going into the fall using this to figure out what is essential; as a way to communicate with students/parents expectations.

- Molly Looking at it through the lease of students Could students pull work out of a portfolio that demonstrates certain skills? How are students reflecting about this?
- Looking to student acing voice/choice
- · Likely we'll find some revisions when in use

Level of language in the document -

- Lots of high-level teacher jargon
- · What will this look like going forward
- · Need a common understanding among staff
- Aligning our work to these documents
- Wording can't be too vague too wide a gap in understanding, won't be useful
