Options Department's Mission Statement


We partner with homeschool families to provide flexible options for scholars to thrive academically, socially, and emotionally.

Role of the Educational Facilitator

Overarching goal = support the teaching parent

- Support curriculum choices and personalizing scholar's learning
- Review and track academic progress
- Support ordering process
- Review work assignments
- Maintain scholar records
- Review for compliance





Role of the Options Learning Coach

- Support scholar's learning style
- Monitor coursework completion
- Connect with EF
- Share work samples and progress
- Log daily activity
- Create learning space, daily/weekly schedule
- Review Handbook











- Important discussion
- Phone or hangout
- Curriculum, progress, strengths, areas for growth
- Regular at least twice a month
- Scholars included
- Additional support






