Performance:

Members were asked to evaluate each potential vendor based on their preferred category within our rubric structure. Each ranked items on a scale of 1 to 4, with 1 being "Never" or "Not Evident" and 4 being "Extremely Evident" or "Always." Reviewers are also given space in which to write comments and are encouraged to be as thorough and detailed as possible to ensure that decision makers have access to a comprehensive evaluation when selecting a curriculum provider. Below is a summary of the rubric results, the highest ranking vendor was Accelerate Education with the exception of Karen Houle and Lynn Woodley.

Recommendation:

Our final recommendation is for Compass Charter Schools to cancel our existing partnership with K12 and StrongMind and pursue Accelerate Education for grades K-12 Online for the upcoming 2020-21 school year.

Along with a unanimous voice from teachers on the curriculum and LMS capabilities and features, Accelerate Education has two-way integration through Agilix-Buzz and School Pathways (Edgenuity did but Apex did not). Our hope in having one curriculum provider for all grades K-12 online is to provide a consistent, all in one platform that all teachers and scholars will benefit from with a more teacher-guided approach with access to a vast assortment of reporting features and top of the line curriculum.

Although many teachers and families are comfortable with K12, I feel that AE will provide more engagement with K-5 families as well as more oversight and academic support on behalf of the teachers to help increase state testing scores and ensure we are meeting our LCAP goals. With the minimal support we get from K12 and the potential for continued miscommunication between K12 and our CCS families, I would like to see us leave K12 completely. Ultimately, this will ensure a truly personalized education with abilities to support the needs of each and every online scholar.
