LCP - Overview

- The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (LCP) is replacing the 2020-21 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)
- Focuses on the following:
 - Implementation of quality instructional program and response to community needs during COVID-19
 - Pupil Participation and Progress
 - Supports for Pupils With Unique Needs
 - Pupil Learning Loss
 - Pupil Learning Loss Strategies
 - Mental Health and Social Emotional Well Being





LCP - Overview

- ❖ We are at an advantage since we are a virtual public charter school and our distance learning program has proceeded uninterrupted since the Governor's release of the "Stay At Home" order on March 13, 2020.
- ❖ 500+ new scholars may have experienced learning loss; this plan is designed to ensure their needs are met while addressing their learning loss caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Addresses the need for implementation of new mental health and social emotional well-being programs and initiatives.
