By focusing on scholar engagement, 100% of eligible scholars will graduate by the end of the 2020-21 academic school year.




CCS Senior Class of 2021 - Graduation Eligibility by Term







CCS:TK-5 English Learner Pass Rates in ELA & ELD Course (Lexia, Core5)

TK-5 EL Scholars Pass/Fail Rates (Number of EL scholar = 67)
















CCS:TK-5 English Learner ELA Grades vs. Live Support Session Attendance from 10/20 - 01/21

CCS-TK-5 ELD Live Support Session Attendance






CCS:6-12 English Learner ELA Grades vs. Live Support Session Attendance from 10/20 - 01/21



CCS:TK-5 English Learner Progress in Core5 (Lexia) from September 2020 BOY to February 2021 MOY (Total number of EL scholars = 67)





CCS: 6-12 English Learner Progress in PowerUp (Lexia) from September 2020 BOY to February 2021 MOY
















Scholar Support SST Meetings Held











Scholar Success/MTSS Average Weekly Tutoring Attendance

Compass Charter Schools Average Weekly Tutoring Attendance 6-12








Scholars that Did Not Attend Reading Tutoring










Scholars that Did Not Attend Math Tutoring



READING: MTSS Tier 2 and Tier 3 Scholars





% of Increase for all scholar VSW registrations received between 1/20/2021 & 3/9/2021








% of Growth for Scholar Clubs Sign Ups between Fall and Spring Club Kickoff







Scholars with IEP's by School







Summary

Driving factors for success this year:

- ASIT meetings for Options scholars (early identification and intervention) rather than having scholars fall more than 2 grade levels behind and assessing for SPED services
- MTSS workshop more people felt comfortable implementing tiered interventions and supporting LCs; this also helps support scholar achievement. This goes hand in hand with improvements in the SST process
- PLCs--dedicated time for STs to dig into various relevant topics, upcoming processes, best practices to support our scholars, etc.
- Adoption of one consistent, research- and data-driven ELD curriculum, Lexia, and direct support sessions for EL scholars; seeing gains in English proficiency levels
- Small scholar to counselor ratios allowing for more personalized and frequent support, evidenced in increased concurrent enrollment and graduation eligibility
- Improved tracking of connection meetings via use of contact manager in SIS; looping in families early for successes and barriers
