Our vision is to create a collaborative virtual learning community, inspiring scholars to appreciate the ways in which arts and sciences nurture a curiosity for life-long learning, and prepare scholars to take responsibility for their future success.





- 1. New two (2) EL Tutors (grant-funded through 23/24) have allowed us to providing tutoring twice a week with additional Q&A and 1:1 sessions weekly for our EL population (compared to twice a month in 20/21).
- 2. Positions have been posted for the three (3) new Resource Specialists (grant-funded through 23/24) in ELA, Math, and Reading to help further support scholars with skill-based small groups to further target instruction.
- 3. For dyslexia screening referrals this year, our Scholar Support Coordinator is using the Renaissance STAR Curriculum-Based Measurement (CBM). This screener is designed to identify areas of concern and components of reading that may suggest characteristics of dyslexia. The results from the screener can further personalize interventions that focus on scholar strengths and weaknesses. The use of the CBM is being reviewed as a potential universal dyslexia screener (UDS) as we prepare for the probably passing of SB 237 for Fall of 2022.
- 4. Our Scholar Support Coordinator Scholar Support Coordinator is supporting the AB 104 retention/promotion request process with the management and scheduling of fourteen (14) since September 1st.

Live, virtual support sessions hosted by our EL tutors


- ELD direct support sessions are offered twice weekly

- Additional office hours and 1:1s are available by request








TK-5 English Learner Progress in Core5 (Lexia) from Sept 2020 to June 2021





Percentage of MTSS Scholars At or Above Grade Level - Reading








Changes in Tier 2 and Tier 3 MTSS Scholars BOY vs MOY vs EOY- Reading

Scholar Support

- 1. 504 Scholar Diagnostic Results
 - a. ELA: K-5 improved from 67% at or above grade level on the initial diagnostic (September) to 86% on the final/end of year (June).
 - b. Math: K-5 improved from 68% at or above grade level on the initial diagnostic (September) to and 83% on the final/end of year (June).
 - c. ELA: 6-12th grade improved from 42% at or above grade level on the initial diagnostic (September) to 58% on the final/end of year (June).
 - d. Math: 6-12th grade improved from 16% at or above grade level on the initial diagnostic (September) to and 27% on the final/end of year (June).
