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Summer Session Highlights

- Summer Session took place July 5-July 29, 2022\
- A total of 239 scholars participated
 - o 132 K-8
 - 108 HS
- 8 Teachers, 1 Coordinator, and 1 Counselor supported scholars during the session





Summer Session Grades K-8

- Families were given the choice to take an Art class through Accelerate Education and participate in a Summer Session Subscription or participate in two Summer Session Subscriptions
- Many families signed up for Summer Session Subscriptions
 - o 129 signed up all together
 - 32 families signed up to only participate in Summer Session Subscriptions





Summer Session Grades K-8

- Scholars in grades K-5 participated in Art Development courses while scholars in grade 6-8 participated in Basic Drawing and Beginning Painting through Accelerate Education
 - o 65 scholars signed up for the K-5 Art Development courses
 - 33 scholars signed up for Basic Drawing or Beginning Painting
 - Of these scholars, 66% worked through their Accelerate
 Education Art course





- Along with the Summer Session Subscriptions and Accelerate Education Art courses, scholars were able to participate in weekly, live sessions with the K-8 Summer Session teachers.
 - These live sessions were requested by families during the Summer Session Townhall last spring
 - An average of 50 scholars attended these session each week during the summer


















- Scholars going into 9th grade through 12th grade had the opportunity to participate in Summer Session to earn credits towards high school graduation
- This summer, scholars were able to take credit recovery classes and other electives to earn credits ahead of time
 - 10 incoming 9th graders participated in Summer Session to earn credits ahead of time




Summer Session K-8 Engagement
