Updates

San Diego charter renewal- the initial charter draft has been submitted to YMC for review. Legislation is pending that will extend charter renewal for another year. If it passes we will assess our options.

We have lost our lease at the OCLC. We are currently looking for space for the next school year. We have not received a response from the SAUSD Superintendent about being able to stay in the district long-term.

The State Board of Education met on May 18th to consider changes to the verified data process. I participated in a call with SBE and CDE staff to promote understanding of how some of the regulations may impact charters.



Updates

CAASPP completion rates are still low

Los Angeles	75.5%	76.3%
Yolo	68.2%	69.9%

Staff are reaching out to each family who has not completed testing to make sure that they know the impact of their non-participation. We have until the end of May to test scholars.



Updates

We did not receive any applicants for the Firebird and Loud and Proud Scholarships, so we extended the deadline and the PAC graciously agreed to hold a special meeting on June 2nd to review the top candidates.
