



• \$1.16M or 201% increase in Private Foundation/Grants over budget of \$575k


### **State Revenue +\$317k**

• \$394k or 31% increase in Basic Formula payments offset by a \$76k or 46% decrease in Student Transportation reimbursement

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# **Personnel Expenses +\$161k**

 Biggest driver was the decision made to provide in house bus services, which added \$146k in Bus Driver salaries




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# **Contracted Services Expenses +\$256k**

- Believe STL received a \$150k grant from The Opportunity Trust to fund the corresponding \$150k expense that was not part of the original budget
- The Management Company Fee (CMO Fee) is derived as a % of revenue. The \$100k increase in dollars simply relates to the increased revenue generation.






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# **School Operations Expenses +\$235k**

- Student Recruitment increase of \$115k reflects
  a successful campaign to fully enroll students,
  with a waitlist to offset attrition, and kept Believe
  STL at its goal of 100 enrolled students going
  into the last days of the school year.
- Staff Travel Needs Believe's input
- Student Meals increase by \$50k because the budget assumption is \$800 per student based on historical data and the actuals are slightly under \$1300 per student; the \$1300/student cost is used in the FY26 budget

### Clustered Bar Chart: FY25 School Operations Comparison




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# Facility Operations & Maintenance +\$67k

- Security Services included a \$41k expense for fire alarm installation
- Property Insurance was \$29k higher than historical data; This has been adjusted upwards to reflect the real rates in the FY26 budget
