- (email from Bassman 3/2) Mathcounts We had 7 top 10 finishers with the top 5 students overall and 11 qualified for the State Competition on Mar 28. Stargate also had the top team
- (email from Howe 3/2) Robotics Five teams were in attendance and our teams finished in style. 32092A Piece by Piece (Excellence Award), 32092F 404: Name Not Found (Design Award), 32092K Diamond Botz (Innovate Award), and 32092G Gear Girlz (Sportsmanship Award) completed a near sweep of the tournament's judged awards.
- HS Robotics competed at state and three teams qualified for World Championships
- (email from Paul Rightmeyer) Iris Li - Iris qualifies for the second round of the USA Junior Math Olympiad. This is basically equivalent to a student getting into the junior olympics for their sport, but her sport is math (and chess). This is highly highly prestigious!
- Science Olympiad - 4 Stargate teams qualify for state; Our middle school team placed 6th overall out of 33 teams, earning an overall team trophy. Our high school team tied for 6th place and finished 7th after the tiebreaker out of 36 teams.

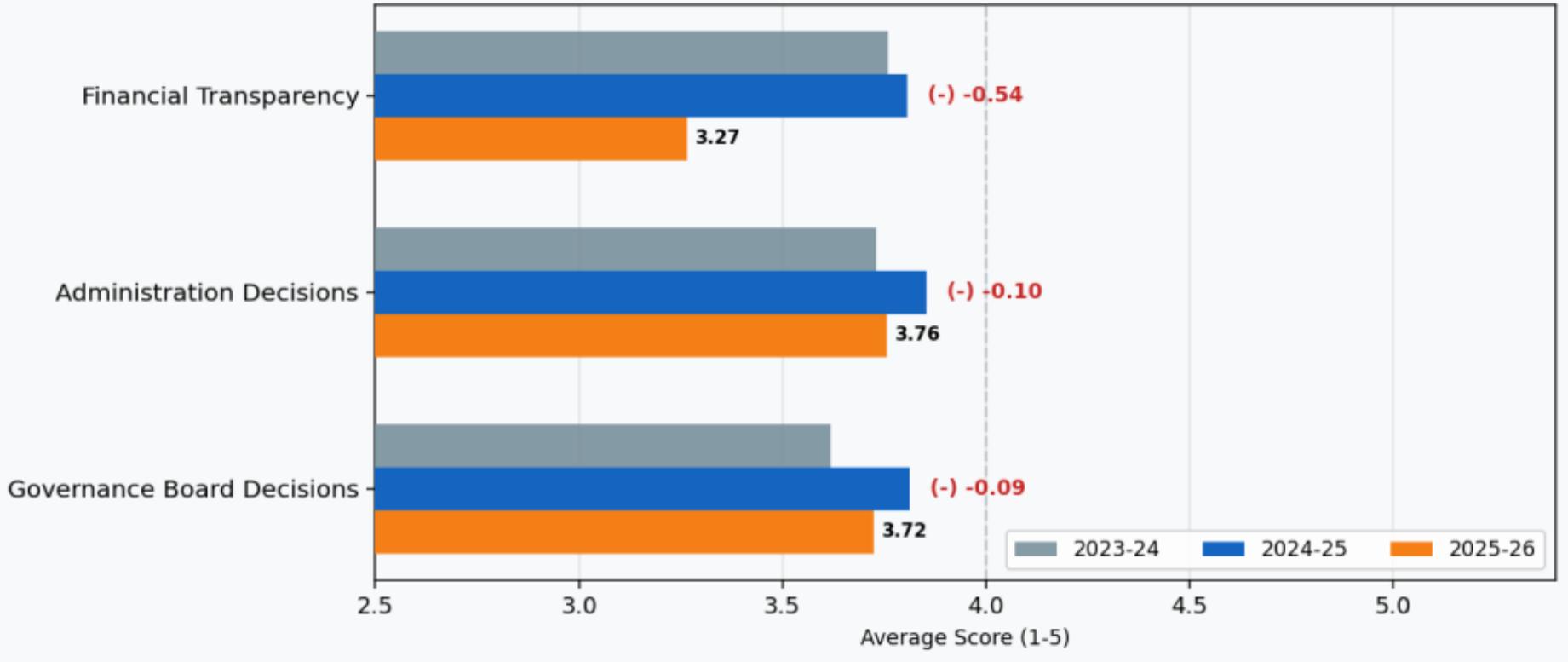

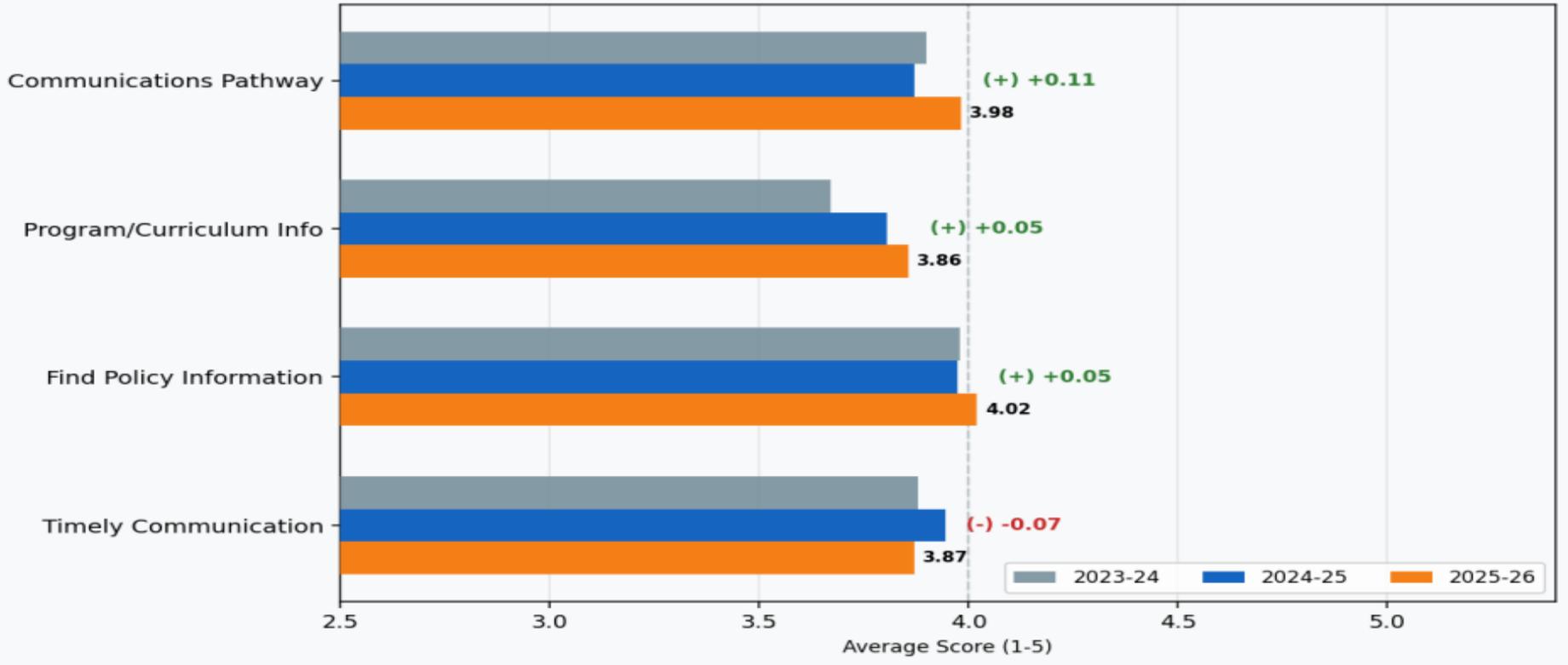
Administration & Governance — 3-Year Trend

Board decisions, administrative direction, and financial communication



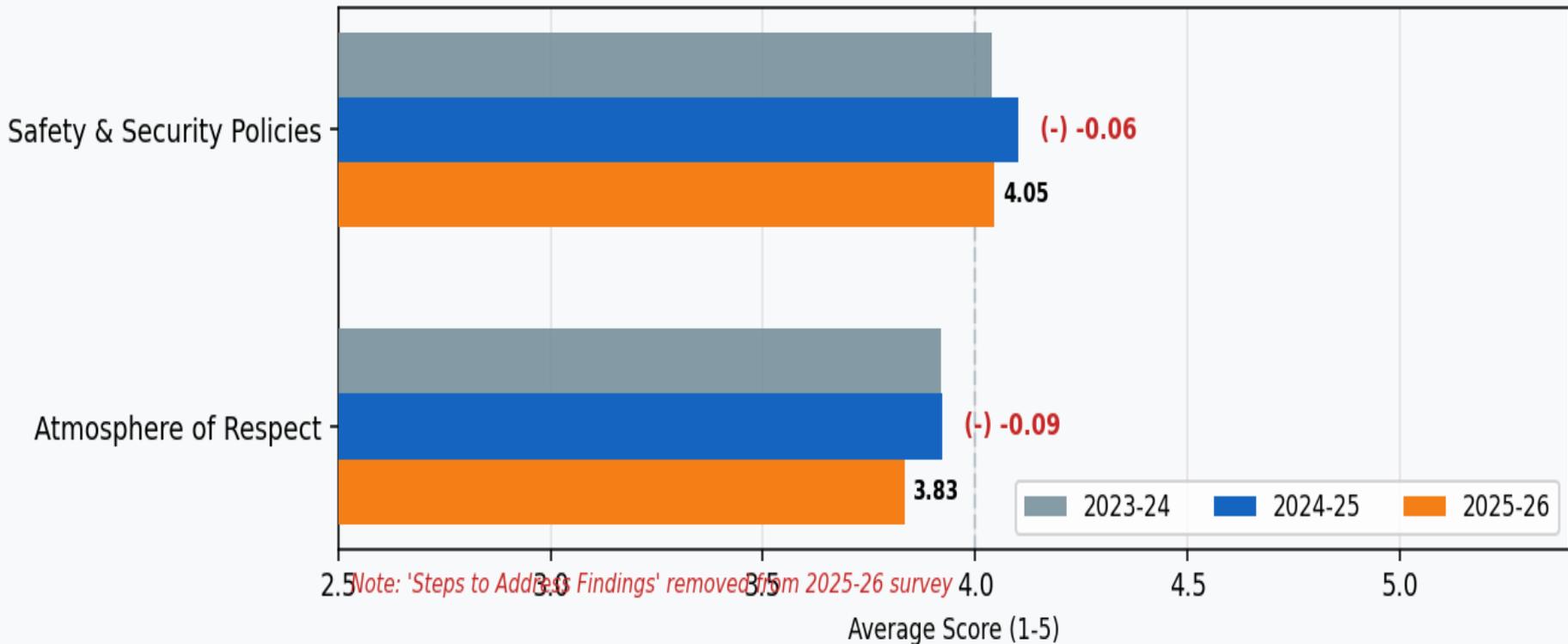
Communication & Information — 3-Year Trend

Timely communication, finding policy info, programs/curriculum, and Comm. Pathway



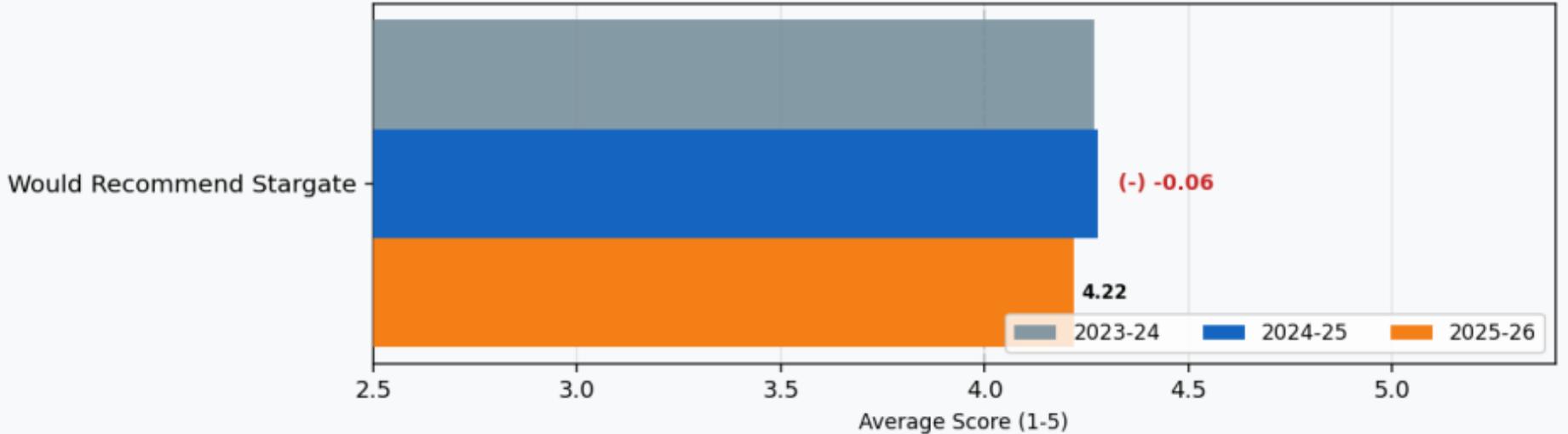
Culture & Safety — 3-Year Trend

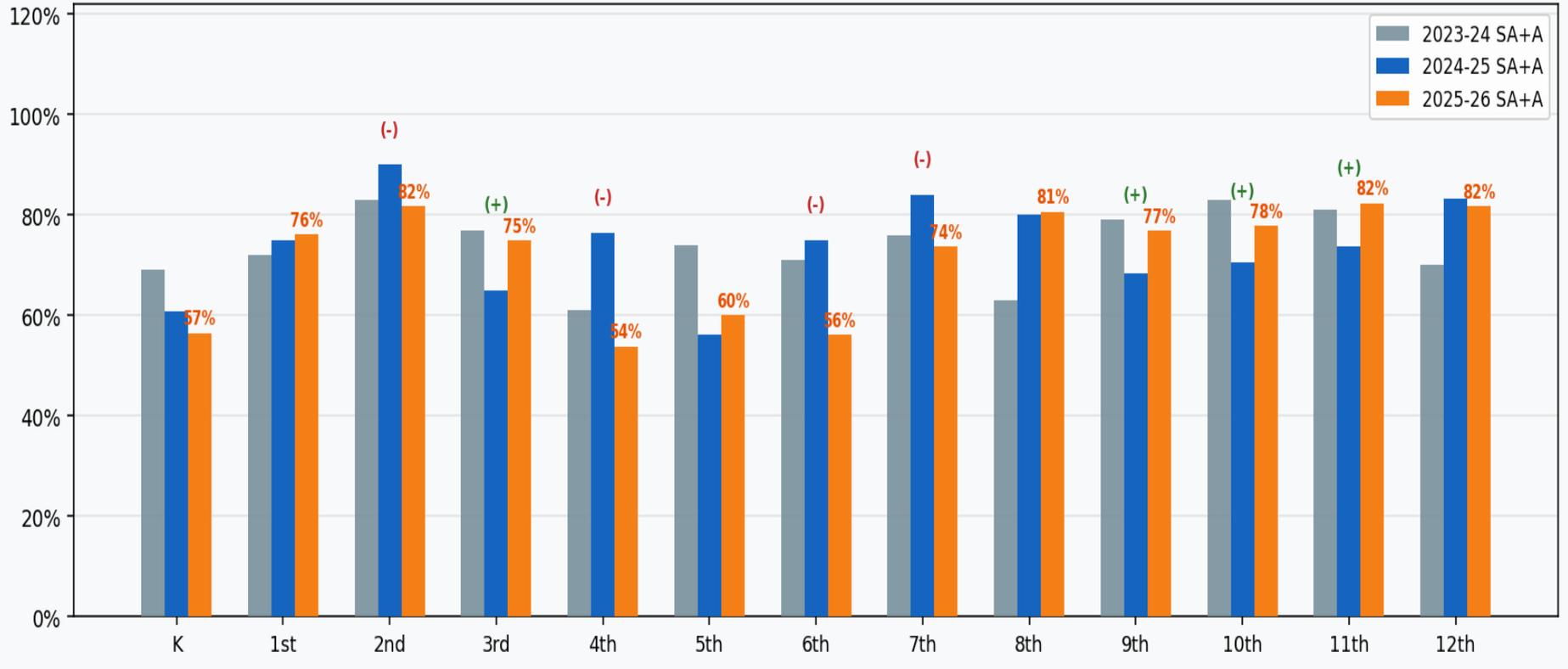

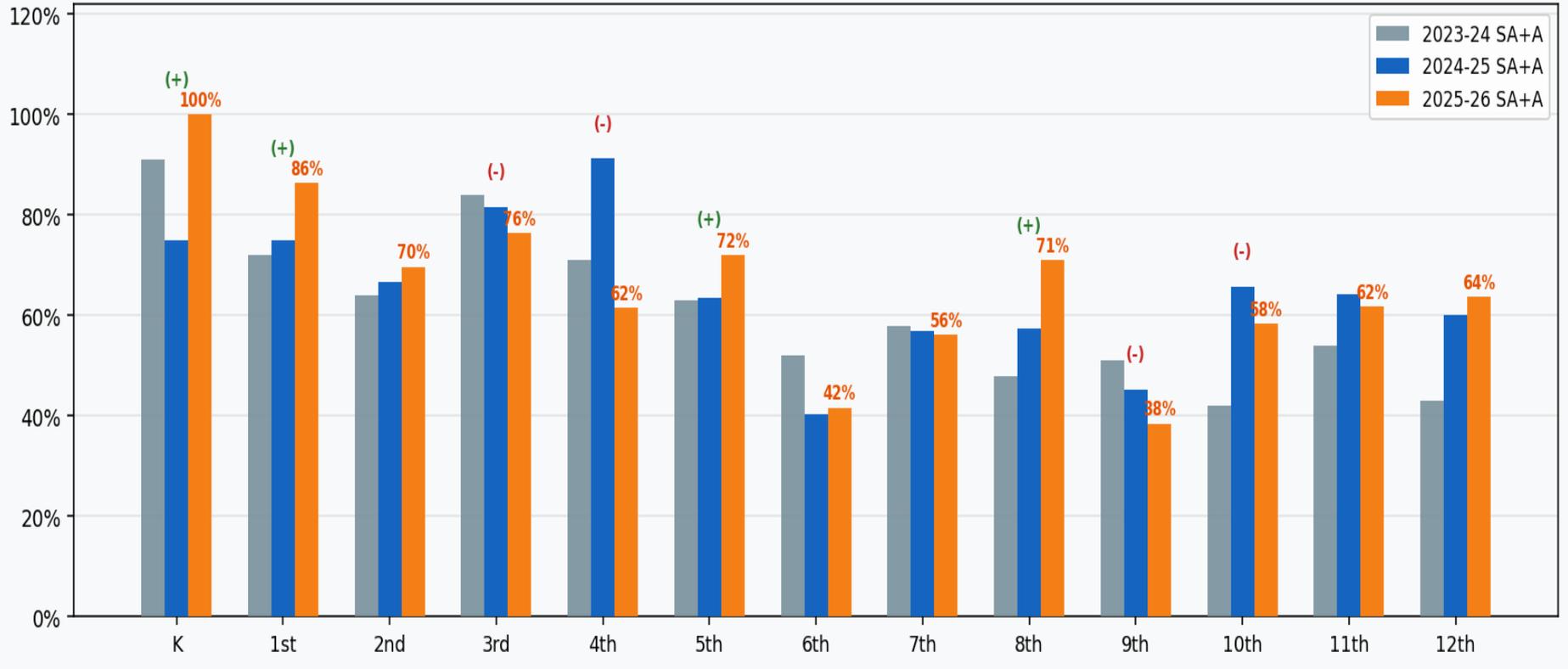
Grade-Level: Transitions — 3-Year Comparison (2023-24 | 2024-25 | 2025-26)

% SA+A: 'Transition between school levels was well-coordinated and positively reinforcing'



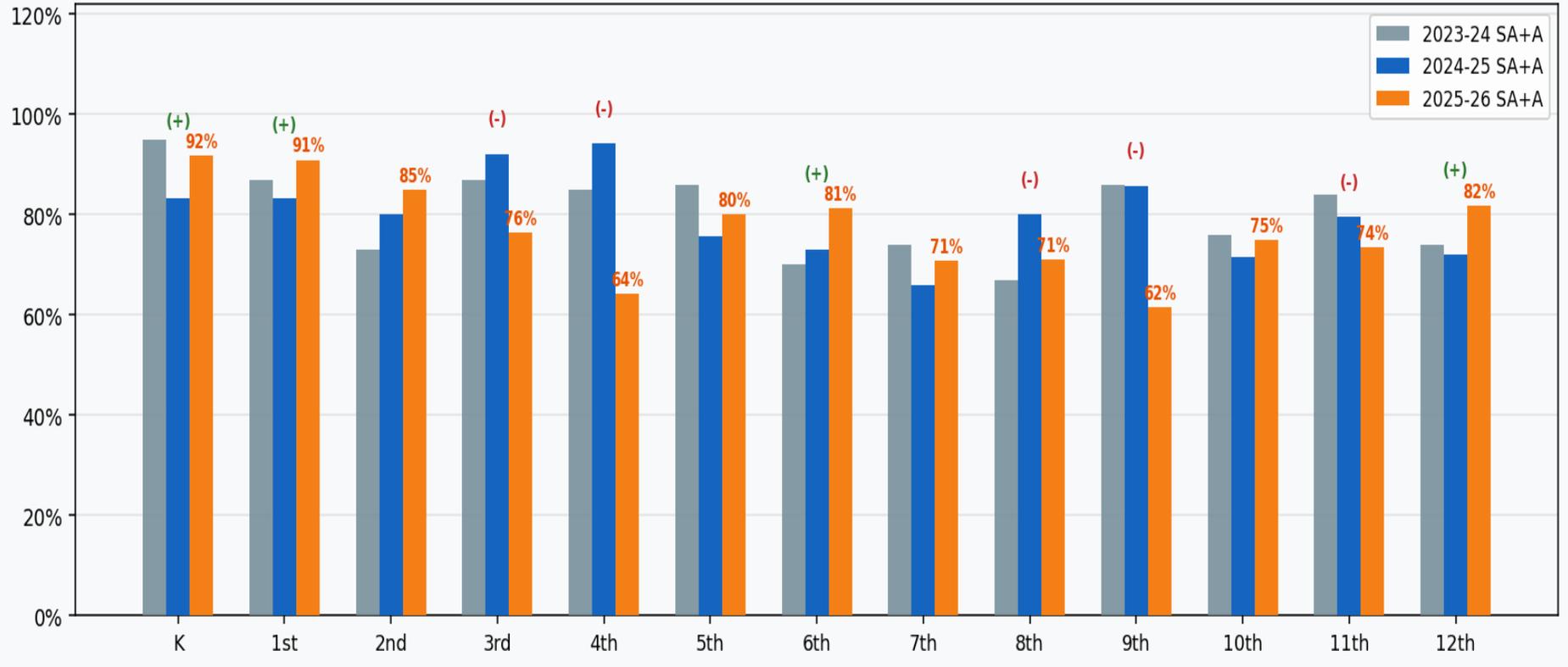
Grade-Level: Teacher Communication — 3-Year Comparison (2023-24 | 2024-25 | 2025-26)

Find Policy Information: Crossed 4.0 threshold (4.02) — strongest in 3 years

Communications Pathway: Improved to 3.98 — highest in 3 years

Would Recommend Stargate: Stable at 4.22 — continued high parent confidence

GRADE-LEVEL — 2025-26 vs 2024-25 KEY SHIFTS

Transitions: 4th grade dropped to 54% (-22pp vs 24-25); Kindergarten 57% needs attention

Teacher Communication: 9th grade at 38% (-13pp); 6th grade at 42% (-30pp vs 24-25)
