Smoking:

Any damage or vandalism done during your stay at any YMCA Camp facility is subject to a minimum repair charge of \$30.00 and will be added to the final payment

We ask that you please properly dispose of your trash and turn off any lights when you depart.
Any excess cleaning as a result of groups not following check-out procedure sheet will result in a minimum of a \$30.00 cleaning charge being added to the check-out payment.

Camping Services requires rental groups to provide a staff member to be on duty at each swimming location and must have a current nationally recognized Lifeguard Certificate, unless otherwise prearranged with camp.
