A. Math Specialist Report by Louisa Marks

Recently hired and Vida's first Math Specialist, Louisa Marks, presented on the results of recent Acadia and CDT testing results for the students. Based on the data, Ms Marks is identifying areas of work and focus for school wide math support for the rest of the year. These will include

- content exposure,
- expectations and incentives for test taking,
- supporting positive outlook and fun in math,
- helping students with testing strategies, and
- starting direct support through math interventions.
