SUBJECT: Amplus Academy AB398 Budget Plan

BACKGROUND:

Nevada's AB398 bill was passed to provide additional funding for public education employees in the state. For public charter schools, the bill specifically appropriates a total of **\$19,314,297** to the State Public Charter School Authority (SPCSA) for both Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The sole purpose of these funds is to provide salary increases for teachers and education support professionals (ESPs). This is a targeted effort by the state to improve compensation and retention in public schools.

How the Money Can Be Used

The guidelines for using this funding are clear and specific:

- **Salary Increases Only:** The funds must be used exclusively to provide salary increases for eligible staff. This money cannot be used for any other purpose, such as operational costs, curriculum development, or capital projects.
- **Supplemental, Not Replacement:** The funds are intended to be supplemental. This means they must be used to increase staff salaries above and beyond our existing budget. They cannot be used to replace or reduce any other funding source currently used for staff compensation.
- **Eligible Staff:** The raises are designated for teachers and education support professionals. Based on preliminary information, this funding is not intended for administrative positions (such as principals, vice-principals, or executive directors).

In order to receive these funds, our charter school will be required to submit an AB398 Budget Plan. This includes a census of our eligible staff and a plan detailing how we intend to distribute the salary increases. This plan will require approval from the Interim Finance Committee prior to receiving our allocation.



Proposed Budget Plan

The following one-time salary adjustment will be disbursed to eligible staff in two installments. The tentative disbursements dates are planned for mid contract year and the end of the contract year pending receipt of the proposed funding. The proposed plan is outlined below:

- **Teachers with a Substitute License (8):** Teachers currently holding a substitute license will receive **\$2,500*** (two \$1,250 installments) for their gross salary adjustment. Many of these teachers are currently in Bachelor's or ARL teaching programs. Our hope is that between this salary adjustment and education reimbursement, they can continue on the path to full licensure.
- **Licensed Teachers with a Bachelor's Degree (38):** Teachers who possess a bachelor's degree will be compensated with **\$4,000*** (two \$2,000 installments) for their gross salary adjustment. While our Bachelor's scale is more competitive, it is still approximately 10% less than CCSD.
- **Licensed Teachers with a Master's Degree (58):** To address a critical retention issue, teachers holding a master's degree will receive **\$6,250*** (two \$3,125 installments) for their gross salary adjustment. Our Master's scale is significantly less than CCSD, at approximately 30% less.
- **PERS:** A portion of the funds will also be used to cover the employer's contribution to PERS for the above mentioned eligible employees.
- Any remaining funds will be split evenly between the licensed teacher with a Master's degree.

**These salary adjustments are based on the Employee/ Employer Split PERS Option. For those with 100% Employer paid PERS, the increases will be as followed:*

- *Teachers with a Substitute License: \$2,083.93 (two installments of \$1,041.96 and \$1,041.97)*
- *Licensed Teachers with a Bachelor's Degree: \$3,334.28 (two installments of 1,667.14)*
- *Licensed Teachers with a Master's Degree: \$5,209.81 (two installment of \$2,604.90 and \$2,04.91)*

Rationale for Allocation

Our primary motivation for this specific allocation is the increasing loss of our highly qualified master's degree teachers to the local school district, CCSD, as well as other charter schools. Our current wage structure for these experienced educators has proven to be uncompetitive, leading to a significant teacher attrition that impacts our students and overall educational quality. In the 2024-25 school year, we lost seven (7) teachers to CCSD and local charter schools that could pay higher salaries. By providing this enhanced compensation, we aim to improve our competitiveness and retain these invaluable assets.

We have elected to not use these funds for other educational support positions. Our analysis indicates that our current compensation for similar support roles remains competitive within the market, and therefore, these funds are best directed where the need for retention and competitiveness is needed in our classrooms. This strategic use of AB 398 funds is designed to directly address our most pressing staffing challenges, ensuring that we can continue to provide high-quality education by retaining our most experienced and qualified teaching staff.
