B. Math and reading NWEA progress - Fall 2025

Susan and Elizabeth shared out our proficiency for NWEA and MTY

Dimensions - Math proficiency was stronger than reading but have interventions and supports

in place for reading

- Watching the "5th grade" learners as they are the lowest proficiency this

Fall

Overman - Reading proficiency stronger than math

- Shared out the sub group data for Economically Disadvantaged and Special Education
- Watching the "8th grade" cohort of learners as they have the lowest proficiency
 - Focusing on math programming and P2C curriculum has added some bridge curriculum which should support the middle level learners

Next step is looking at longitudinal data.
