#### CAO presents:

- MAP and ACT scores are our Northstar and state tests are important
- Last year was the first time we had priorities.
  - Text-Driven Literacy Instruction: adoption of new curriculum. Every student received books and were allowed to keep them.
  - Warm + Demanding Classrooms: focused on the culture of the classroom and the school. Learning was happening from the beginning of the year.
- MAP: strongest predictor and is correlated to ACT and SAT
- Reviewed TNReady data for Math and English for NACS, LCA, and NP
- Reviewed EOC results for RHS in English, Math, and US History
- Reviewed MAAP data for Math, English, and Science for ReImagine Prep and Smilow Prep
